Northrup Creek Horse Camp & Trails

ASTORIA DISTRICT



Northrup Creek Horse Camp is a favorite among horse campers. It is situated in a picturesque, quaint valley that is located in a quiet corner of Clatsop County. This well designed horse camp is nestled amongst the many fir trees and wildflowers that adorn the area. Northrup Creek which winds its way through the moss covered big maples is just across the road.

This facility features eleven campsites; all of which require reservations, please visit ReserveAmerica.com for reservations. Eight of the sites feature corrals (six 4-horse corrals and two 2-horse corrals), three of which feature pull-through parking, large enough to accommodate sleeper style horse trailers. All other corral sites can also accommodate large trailers but are back in. An additional 3 campsites are for Tent / RV camping only.

The campground is located about four miles north of Highway 202, near Milepost 35, on the Northrup Creek Road. Campsites feature a picnic table, fire ring and large parking area. Located within the campground are horse manure bins, two sealed vault toilets and a hand pump style well for drinking and livestock water.



The west side of the campground also features a hiking trail that leads visitors along the banks of Northrup Creek and north to the day use area. The day use area includes a picnic area with tables and stand-up style barbeques.

Just north of the campground is a large parking and day use area, situated at the trail head for the Northrup Creek equestrian trail. This nine mile loop takes riders on a beautiful and diverse trail. Towering fir trees, moss covered maples, colorful wild flowers, and occasional glimpses of Northrup Creek makes every turn an adventure.

Firewood is available for sale on a limited basis when a camp host is present.
