

## KNOW BEFORE YOU GO...

- **Pack it In, Pack it Out:**  
Where trash receptacles are not provided, carry out garbage and leave the area clean for the next visitor to enjoy.
- **Camping and Campfires:**  
Campfires are allowed in designated metal fire rings only. Please do not leave campfires unattended. When you leave please make sure campfires are completely extinguished and cool to the touch.
- **Use of Firearms:**  
Discharging firearms is prohibited. It is illegal to discharge firearms in this area.
- **Motorized Vehicles:** All motorized vehicles are restricted to maintained gravel roads only. Off-road use is prohibited.
- **Logging Operations:** Please be cautious while driving on forest roads. Please drive slow and be on the lookout for log trucks and other forest visitors.
- **Fire prevention:** Be aware of fire regulations and restrictions during fire season.

## Getting there:

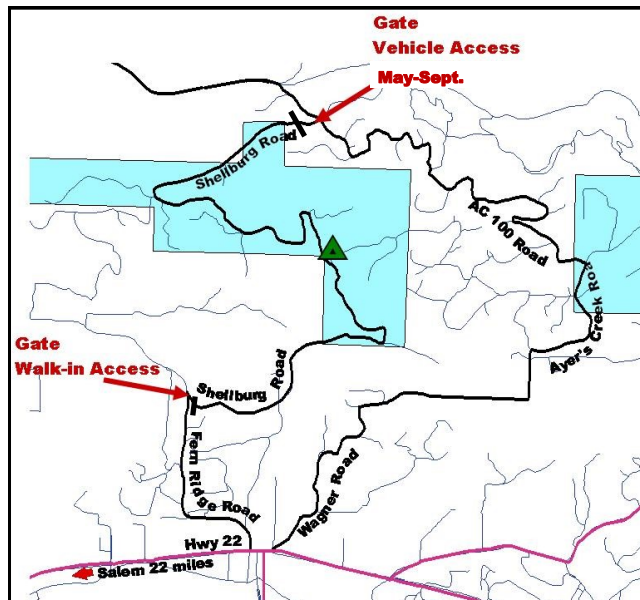
- From Salem take Highway 22 eastbound 22 miles to Lyons, OR.

### *Walk-in Access, All Year*

- Turn Left (North) onto Fern Ridge Road, drive 1.2 miles to end at day-use parking/ yellow gate on right (East) side of road.

### *Drive-in Access, Seasonal (May-Sept.)*

- Turn Left (North) onto Wagner Road, stay right and drive 2.5 miles. Pavement becomes gravel.
- Arrive at 4-way intersection, drive straight (North), Wagner Road becomes Ayers Creek Road.
- Drive 1 mile and turn left (West) onto AC 100 Road.
- Stay on AC 100 Road. Drive 2.8 miles and turn left (West) at yellow gate onto Shellburg Road.
- Drive 2.6 miles to Shellburg Campground.

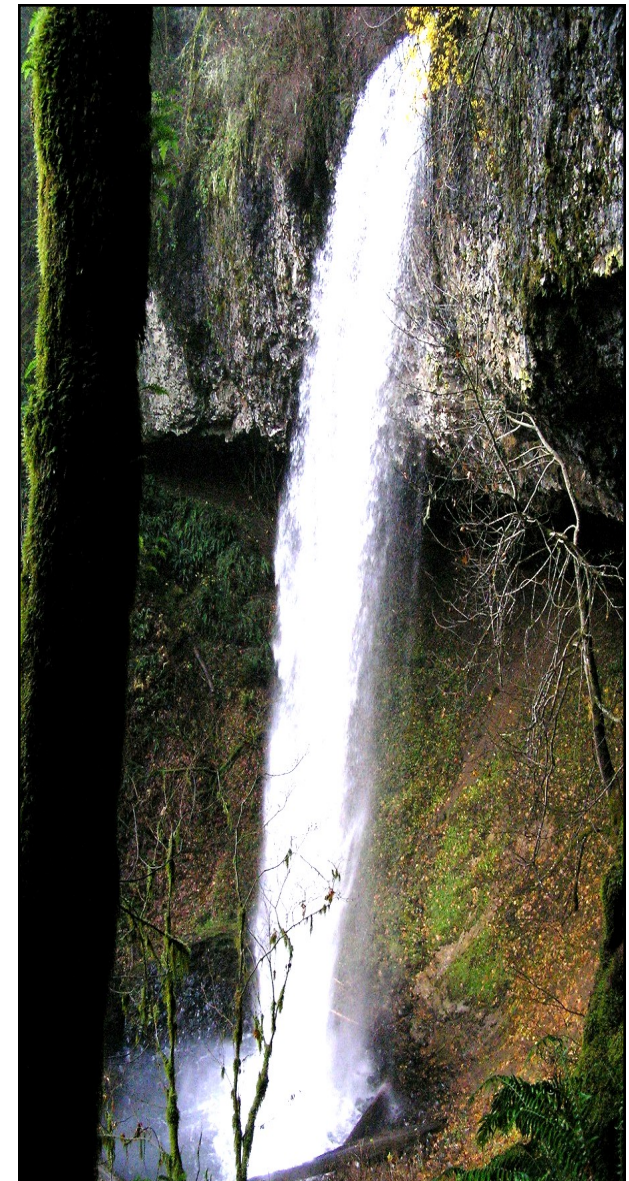

## Shellburg Falls Recreation Area

Shellburg Falls is a beautiful 100 ft. tall fall, with a large cavern carved out behind it. Shellburg Falls Recreation Area offers a variety of opportunities for visitors including hiking, horseback riding, mountain biking, and camping. There are nearly 6 miles of non-motorized, multi-use trails managed by the Oregon Department of Forestry. The Mountain Bike Area is maintained by the Cascadia Trail Crew volunteer organization. Motorized vehicles are restricted to maintained gravel roads only.

**Vehicle Access:** May–September

**Walk-in Access:** All Year

## Shellburg Falls Campground

This secluded campground is a hidden gem. The campground is open May-Sept. It is well maintained and offers restrooms, a hand pump well, picnic tables, fire rings, trash service and a picnic shelter. Please respect other campers and keep the area clean. Quiet hours are in effect from 10 pm-7 am.

**Elevation:** 1,600 feet

**Campsites:**

4 Drive-in Sites: \$20/night

3 Walk-in Sites: \$15/night

(Each site includes 2 vehicles)

Any extra vehicle after the first 2: \$5/night
