I'm proud to announce the first-ever logo for Oregon's State Rehabilitation Council (SRC). This is an exciting step forward in how we present ourselves and communicate our role.

## Why change?

Until now, the SRC didn't have a logo of its own. We work closely with Oregon's Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) program within the Oregon Department of Human Services. However, we are an independent group that listens to the people VR serves and gives advice on how to improve VR services. Having our own logo helps people recognize us as separate from VR.

### **About the logo**

The logo reflects who we are and our values of inclusion, independence and working together.

The design uses a listening icon first to show that listening to the needs of the people VR serves is the first step. Only then can we advocate for policies and practices that improve VR services.



The design also shows our vision that every person

in the VR program will reach their employment goals. The people depicted reach for a common star, symbolizing their individual achievement. This can also be interpreted as VR and the SRC working together to make the program better.

#### What's next

You'll start seeing the logo on our materials, website and other places where we share information. It's part of a bigger effort to make the SRC easier to recognize and connect with.
