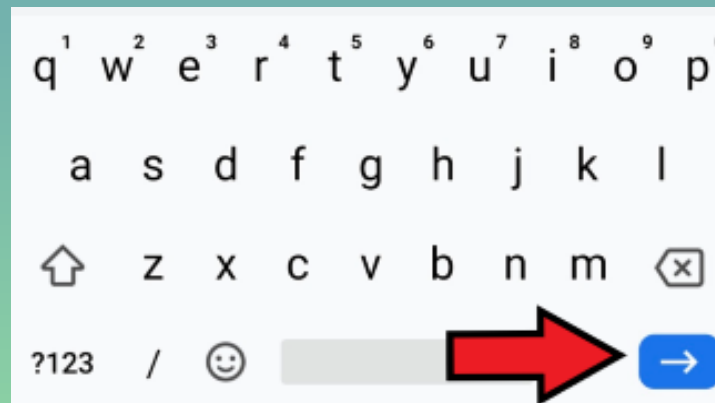
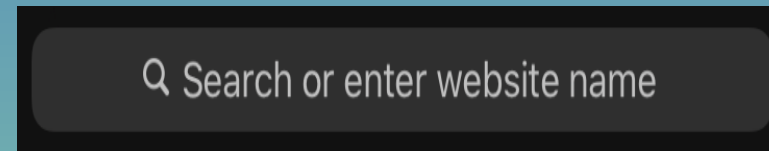


Locating Yahoo

Creating an Account


➤ Click Create account





➤ Click Continue



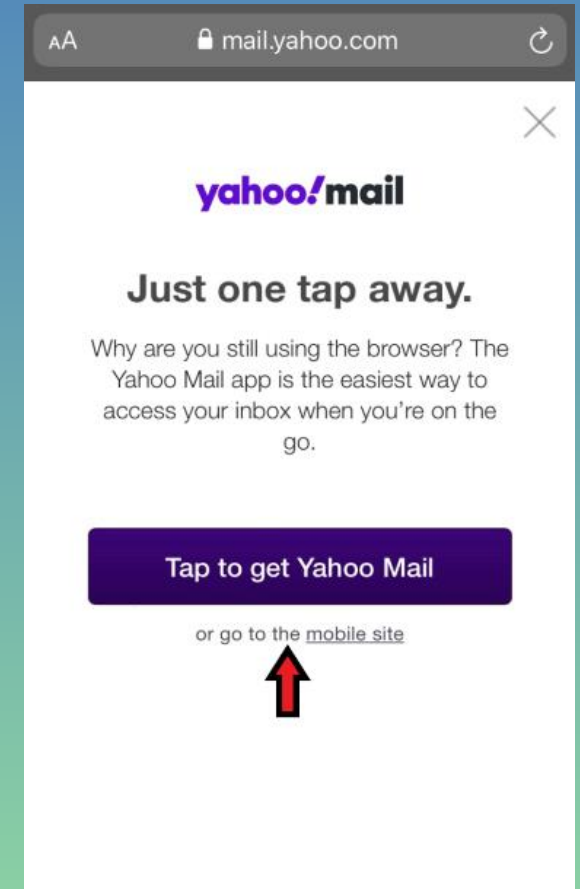
Creating an Account (continued)

 - Download the Application



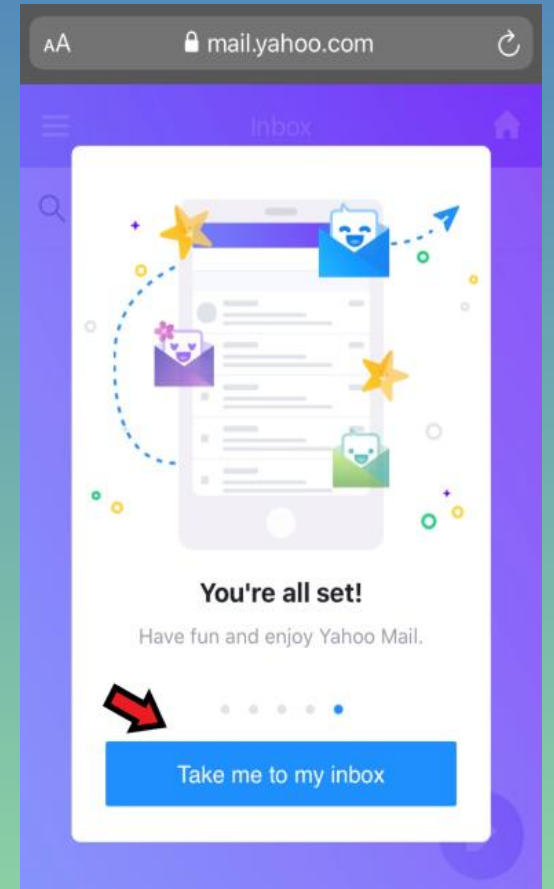
Creating an Account (continued)

 - Click “or go to the mobile site”

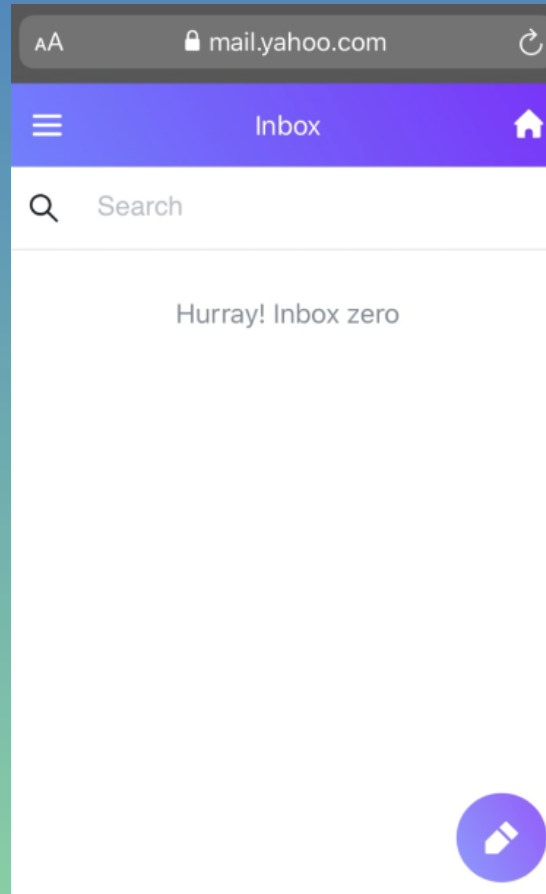


Creating an Account (continued)

 - Click Take me to my inbox



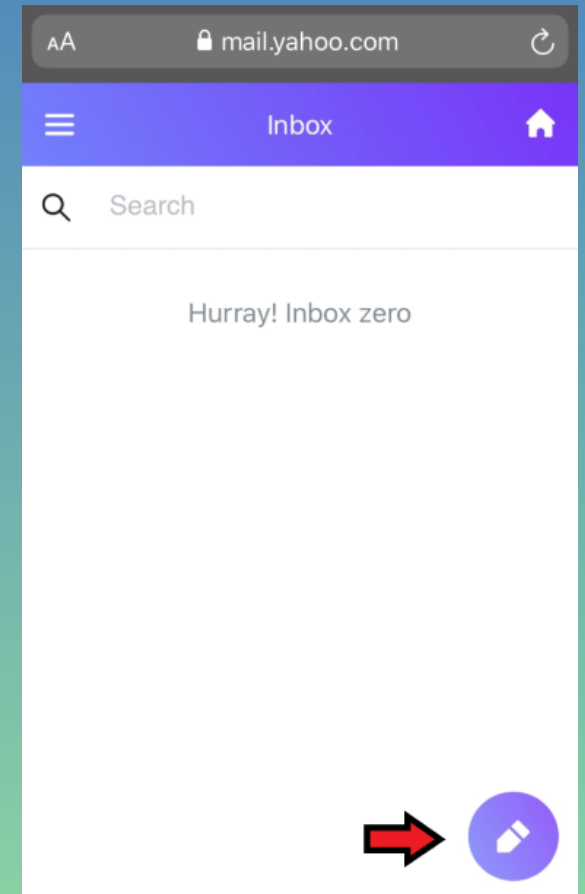
Main/Inbox Screen

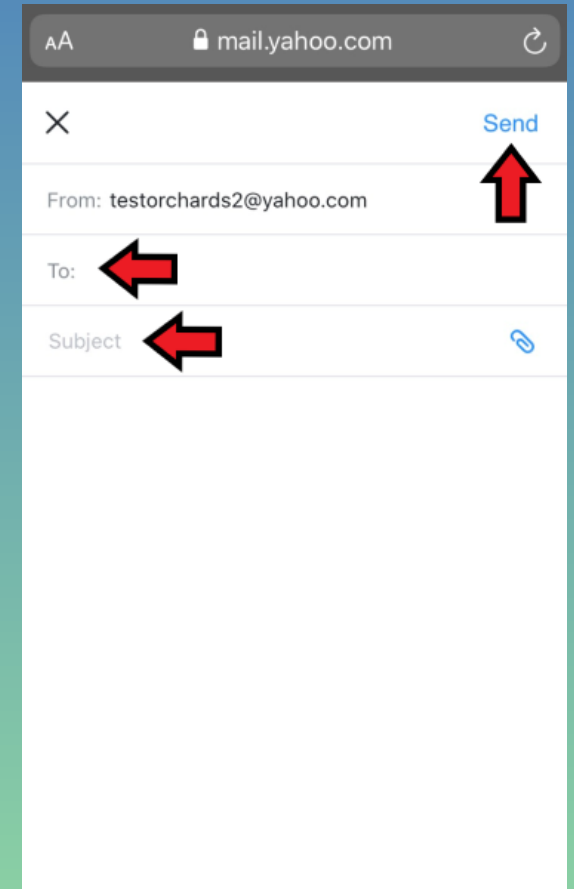
Sending an Email

 - Click Compose button



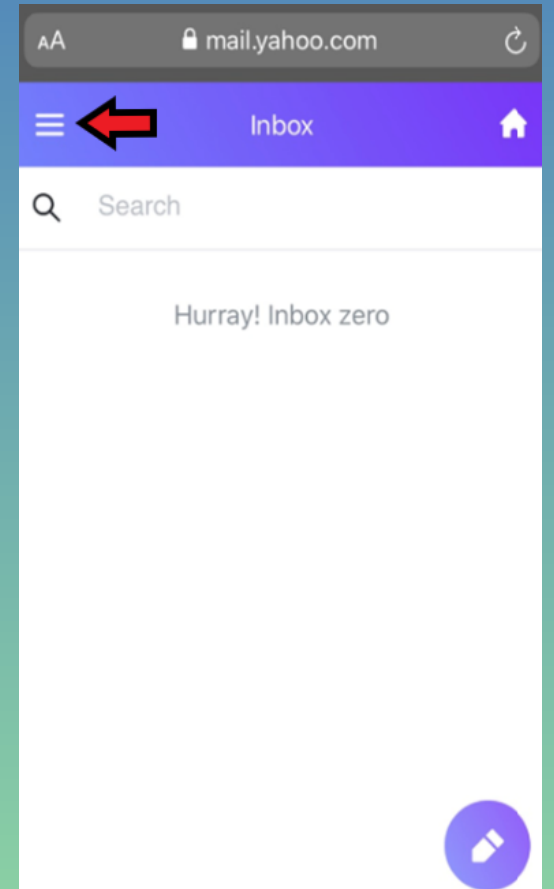
Sending an Email (continued)

Viewing Sent Emails

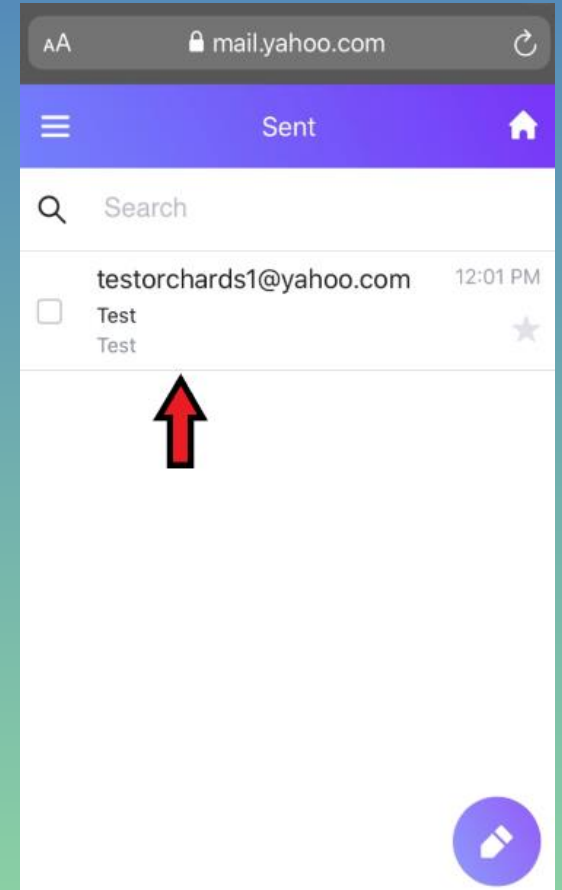
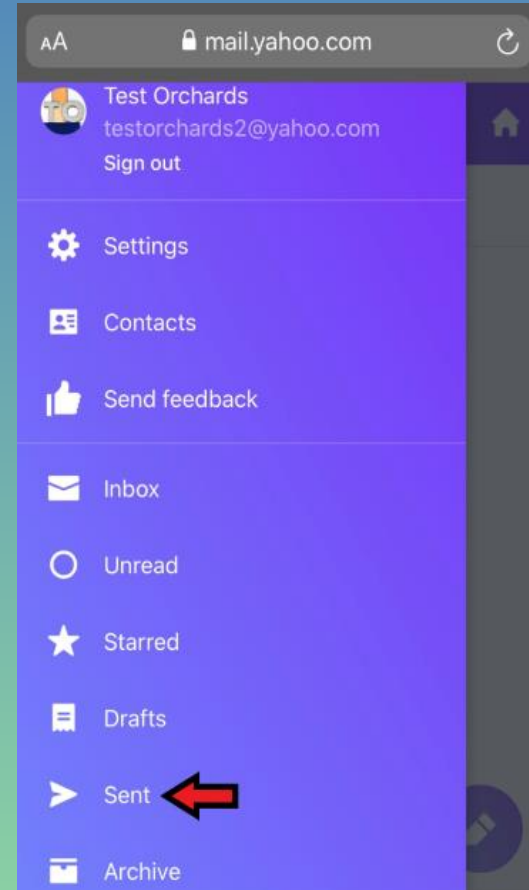
➤ Click Menu button on Inbox screen



Viewing Sent Emails (continued)

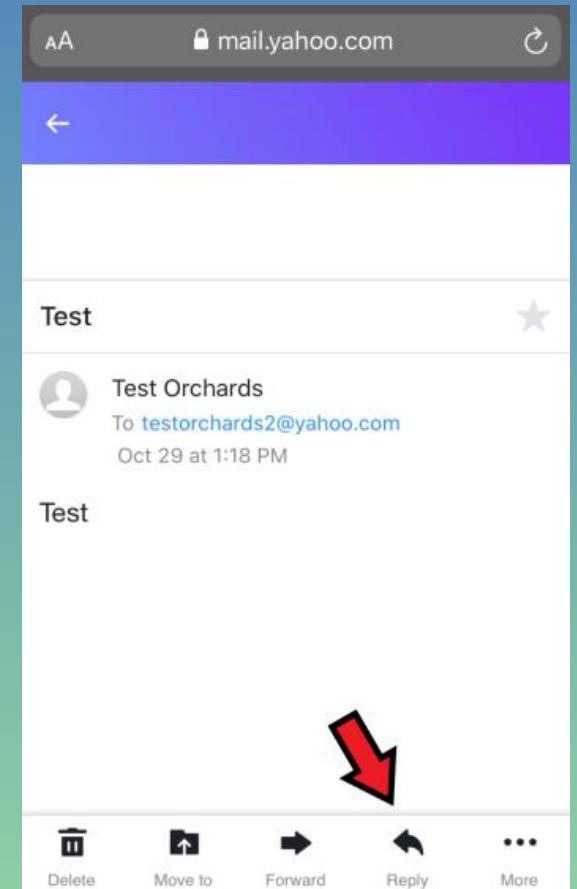
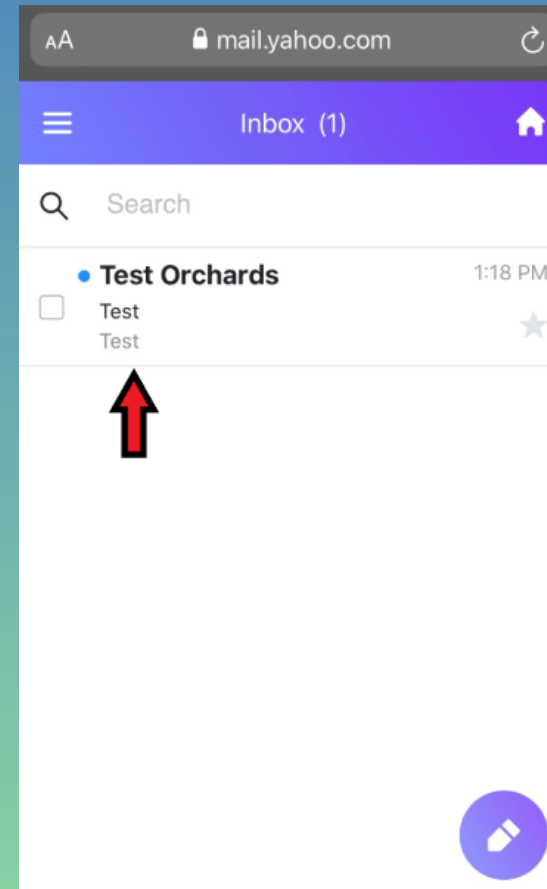
➤ Click Sent

➤ Click on the sent email



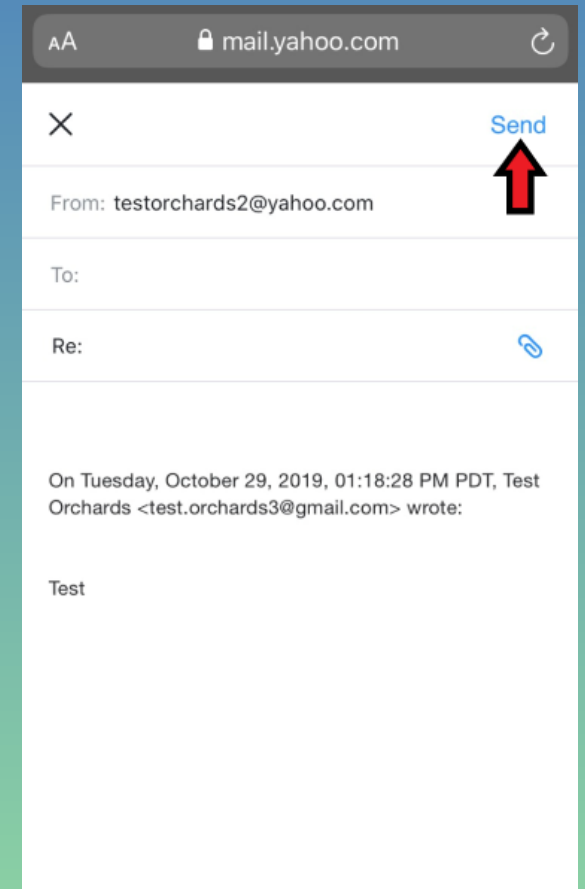
Viewing/Replying to an Email

Viewing/Replying to an Email (continued)

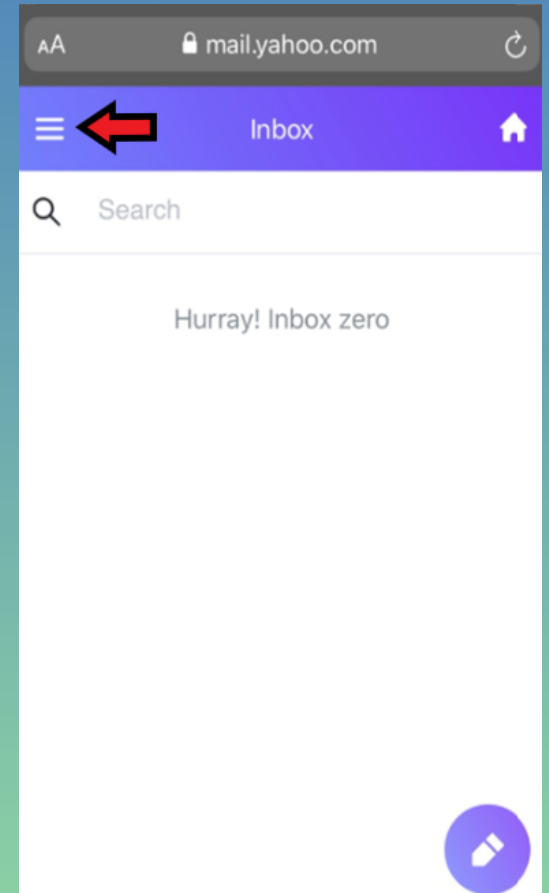
- The message screen will appear

Logging Out of Yahoo

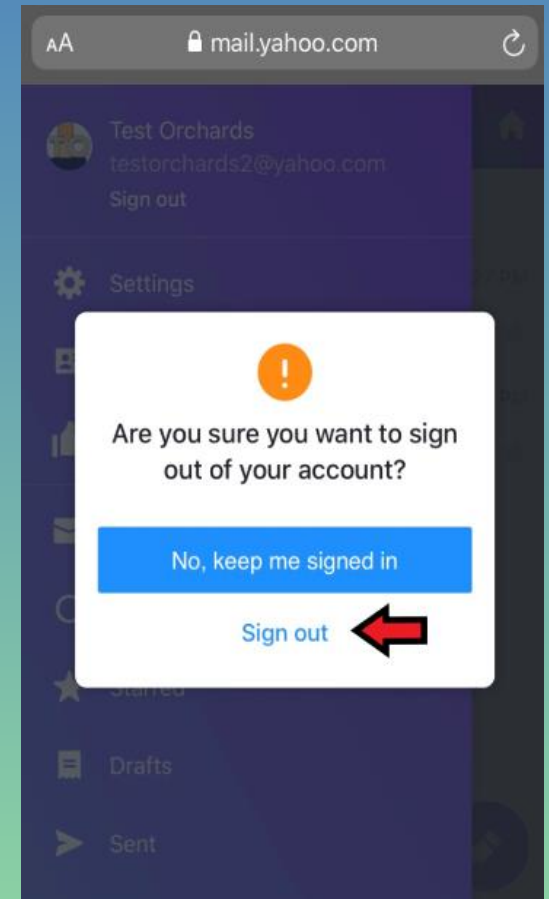
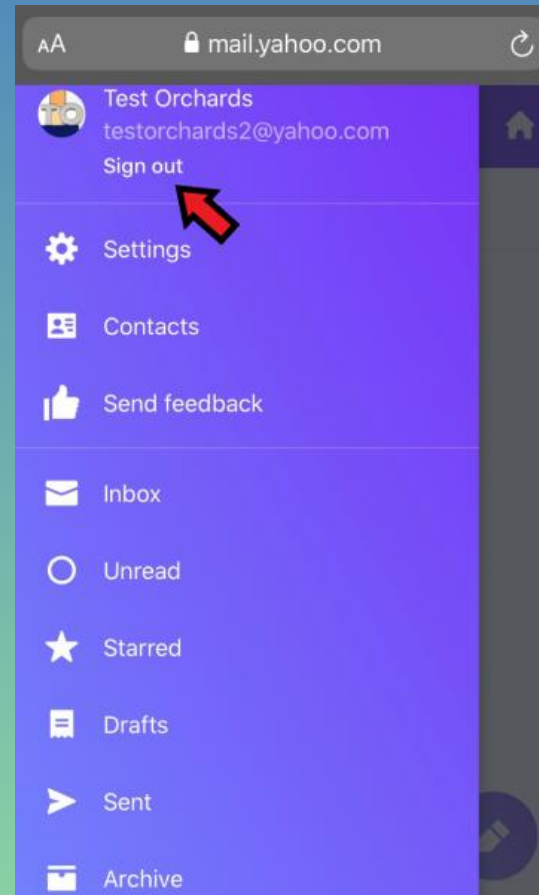
➤ Click the Menu button



Logging Out of Yahoo (continued)


➤ Click Sign out

- Click Next


