

Carina is a free care-matching service for Medicaid and Oregon Project Independence in-home care providers and care seekers. The online Carina tool is available in English, Spanish, and Russian.

To create a free Carina account and find care providers near you:

- Go to <u>carina.org/homecare/medicaid/oregon/</u> or scan the QR code.
- 2. Click "Join for Free."
- 3. Complete sign-up as a "Consumer" by entering your Client ID (Prime Number) as found on your Oregon Health ID card.
- 4. Once you complete sign-up, you may post jobs and message available care providers nearby. Interested care providers may message you as well.
- 5. With potential care providers, schedule a time to chat on the phone and meet in person for an interview. Once you find the right fit, work with your case manager to confirm your new care provider.
