Subject: APD AFH Provider Training for Senate Bill 739 and new OARs

The Department is conducting training for the Senate Bill 739 (SB739) requirements and other minor updates to Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) with an effective date of July 1, 2026. The training for the new OAR standards is for Aging and People with Disabilities (APD), Adult Foster Home (AFH) providers only.

This training is not for AFH providers licensed with the Oregon Health Authority (OHA), the Oregon Department of Disability Services (ODDS) or AFH providers in Multnomah County. For support with the Multnomah County Administrative Rules (MCAR) please contact the local licensing office.
