What is the Report of Foster Provider Training?

This is a recommended form created by the Office of Developmental Disabilities Services (ODDS). This form is not mandatory or part of the renewal application, however, some providers choose to include it. If the provider has training records that show the required training during the inspection, this training credit form is not needed.

How to complete the Report of Foster Provider Training?

The provider will list the trainings they completed as part of their 10 hours of annual training requirement. You will fill out the date, type of training, number of hours that training was, the title of the training, and the agency sponsoring the training, if applicable.

For initial certification, the provider must be able to show 15 hours of pre-service training.

For renewal certifications, the provider must be able to show 10 hours of training per year (20 hours total during certification period).

Other

Providers can find trainings relevant to providing child foster care services to meet the required training hours.

This includes local schools, community programs, online resources, videos and other training programs.

Consultations with health and mental health professionals pertaining to the direct care of a child may be recorded as training. Routine therapy and office visits are not considered to be training.
