Do you have Medicare?

Do you need help with costs at the drugstore? Is the \$121.80 monthly Part B payment hard to afford?

If you have limited income and resources, you may be able to get help.

What kind of help can I get?

Medicare Savings Programs pay the monthly bill for your Part B coverage and may pay other costs too.

Extra Help ("LIS") pays for some of your Part D drug coverage, and may help you pay less at the pharmacy.

Am I eligible?

If your monthly income and your resources (savings) match the guidelines, you may be eligible:

*There is NO Estate Recovery (claim against your estate) with these programs. Income does not include up to \$2,000 per year received by an Alaska Native/American Indian that is derived from individual interests in trusts or restricted lands; or payments to members of specific Indian Tribes as provided by Federal legislation.
