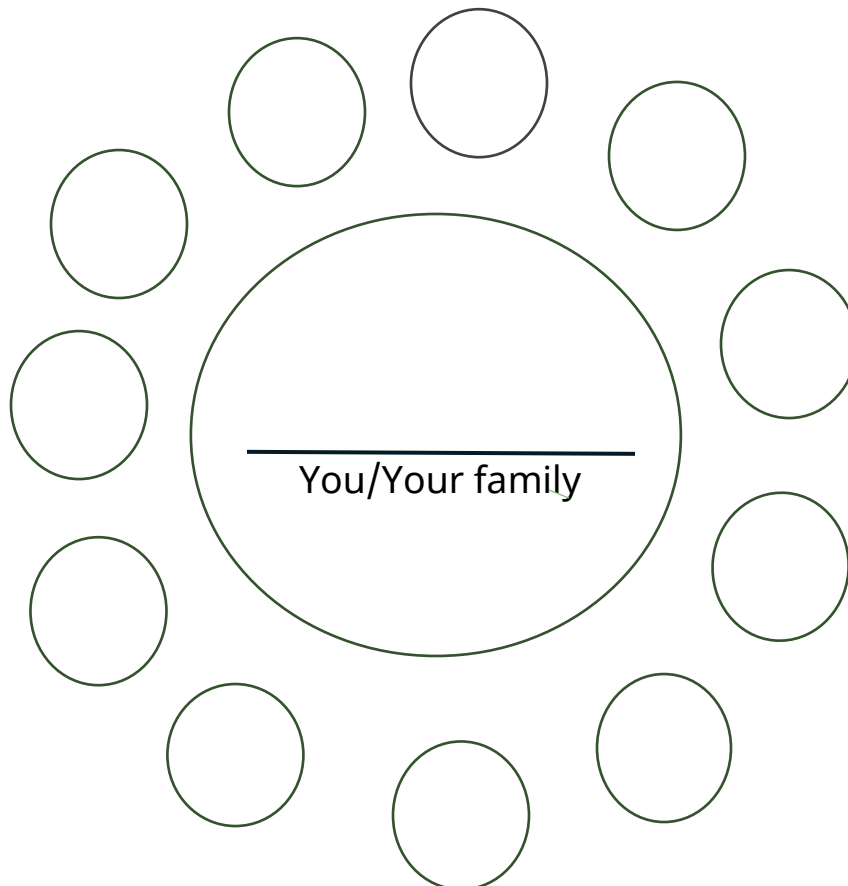
Introduction:

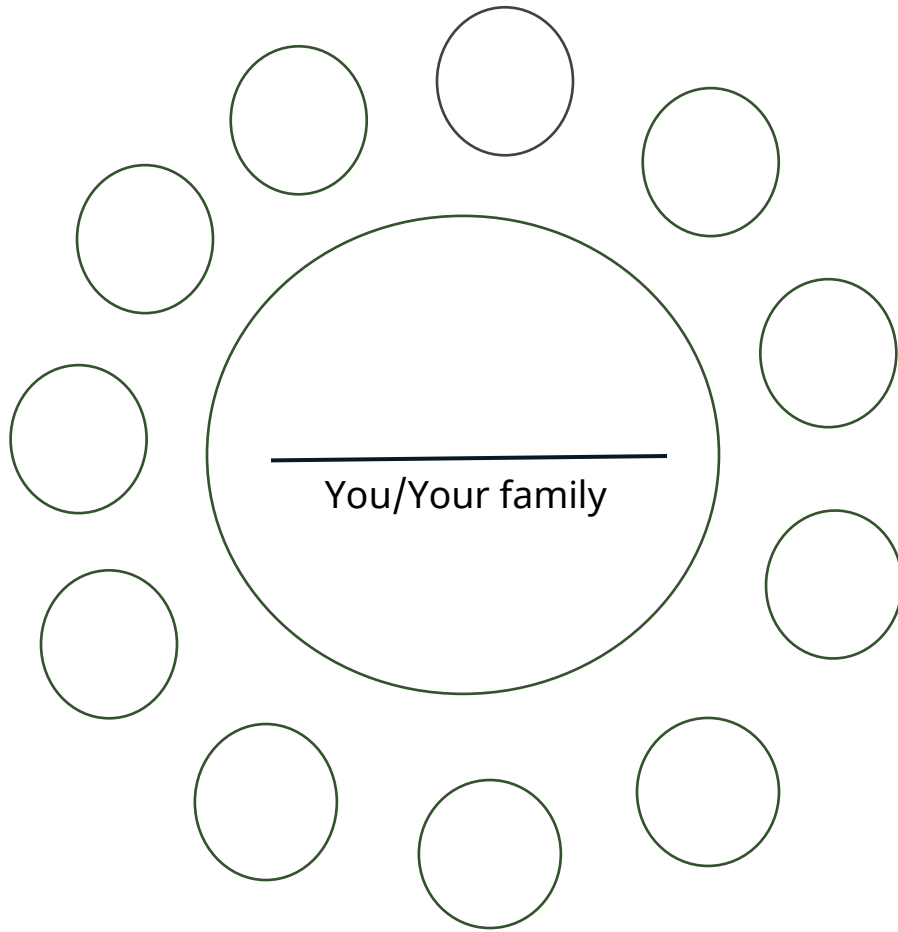
The center circle represents you and your family.

- Write your name in the center circle.

The outer circles represent the support and services you are already connected to, such as the local school, your church, support groups, friends, and family, etc.

- Write the names of these supports and services in the outer circles. Try to think of at least six existing services and supports. Add more circles if needed.
- Draw connecting lines between the center circle and each of the circles with support or services.
- Now identify services you might need once a child moves into your home and draw a squiggly line between the services or support and the center.
