

Oregon Department of Human Services Aging and People with Disabilities (APD) Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) Timeline

By March 17, 2023

- All APD-licensed HCBS providers must be in full compliance with all HCBS rules, as required by the federal Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS).
- For individuals who need a limitation, all Medicaid Case Managers must include Individually-Based Limitations (IBL) in individual's person-centered service plan, as appropriate.

April 2023

- CMS performed onsite Heightened Scrutiny visit of six HCBS settings in Oregon.

June 2023

- CMS issued findings from the April 2023 onsite visit.
- Oregon's Corrective Action Plan was approved, effective March 17, 2023.
- Oregon responded to CMS findings with remediation plans.

July 1, 2023 – December 1, 2023

- Oregon works on all corrective action items and provides trainings statewide.
- Oregon and CMS will meet quarterly to review milestones and progress on remediation plans.

January 1, 2024 – March 31, 2024

- All APD-licensed residential providers take mandatory online HCBS/IBL training.
- Medicaid Case Managers and their Supervisors, Licensors, and Surveyors will take the online HCBS/IBL training.

April 1, 2024 – June 30, 2024

- Licensors and Surveyors will work with providers to ensure IBLs are in place and to address/remove barriers to full compliance with HCBS rules.
- Oregon ensures providers have taken the training and completes corrective action items.

July 1, 2024 - ongoing

- All providers must be in full compliance with all HCBS rules.
- For individuals who need an IBL, all Medicaid Case Managers and Providers must include required IBL documentation in the individual's person-centered service plan/care plan.
