

Oregon's traditional health worker certification agencies

There are two Traditional Health Workers (THW) certifying authorities in Oregon:

- **Oregon Health Authority (OHA)** approves/certifies curriculum developed by others for:
 - Community Health Worker
 - Personal Health Navigator
 - Peer Wellness Specialist
 - Peer Support Specialist (five sub-specialties)
 - Doula
- **Oregon Home Care Commission (OHCC)** trains and certifies experienced and qualified homecare or personal support workers for:
 - Community Health Worker
 - Personal Health Navigator

OHCC only provides trainings for Personal Support (PSW) and Homecare Workers (HCW).
