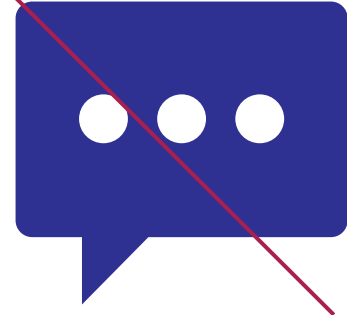
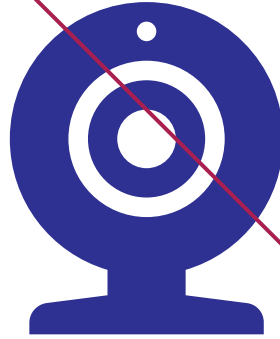

APD-AR-26-014 OPI-M Oregon ACCESS security changes for AAAs

Target audience: Type A and B AAA, OPI-M Supervisors

Action needed – Complete by June 30, 2026:

- Additional security rights are needed for OPI-M SCMs to complete all required OPI-M tasks in Oregon ACCESS.
- Type A supervisors must submit an updated Individual User Profile form 0784 for each OPI-M SCM in their office.
- Type A supervisors will need to request a specific template by sending an email to: opim.support@odhsoha.oregon.gov or apd.security-requests@odhsoha.oregon.gov with “AAA template” in the subject line.
