The Employer Resource Connection program (formerly named STEPS) has created a new resource for consumers who are interested in hiring homecare workers. "What You Need to Know as an Employer of a Homecare Worker (DHS 2914)" is a short guide that provides consumers with information about:

- The employer-employee relationship;
- How to meet employer responsibilities;
- Maintaining a safe, harassment-free work environment;
- Having someone help with employer responsibilities, if needed;
