<u>Message</u>:

In response to the change in policy that temporarily allows homecare workers (HCW) 150 days to complete orientation (refer to <u>APD-PT-20-026</u>), the Oregon Home Care Commission (OHCC) will enable homecare workers to be available for referral on the Registry past the 90-day edit currently in place. To accomplish this, <u>OHCC</u> staff will run a daily report and manually update the HCW Orientation field in the Registry for new workers until further notice. Workers will be able to complete their profile and respond to Help Wanted Ads posted on the Registry by consumer-employers.

In order to temporarily increase the pool of available homecare workers to respond to the needs of consumer-employers during the COVID-19 pandemic, OHCC will change the status of workers currently designated as "Unavailable-HCW Orientation needed" to "Available for Referral." OHCC staff will manually enter an orientation date of 1-1-20 and OHCC as the orientation location. OHCC will remove this information when standard operating procedures resume.
