This transmittal is to inform local offices that due to system updates; the Oregon ACCESS School House training environment now has limited functionality. Staff will encounter error messages when using the training environment, such as when an attempt is made to sync treatments to the Mainframe or when approving Benefits, Hours, and Service plan segments on the Service Planning screen. These limits <u>do not</u> apply to the live environment, <u>only</u> the training environment.

Update: The OA School House training environment is now working with some limitations since there is no connection to the ONE system. Most functionality is working as it should be, except the following:

- Generation of the ONE version of the pay-in worksheet
- The IE/ME Information screen (because there is no connection to the ONE system)
