## Groups within Phase 1a of the Oregon Health Authority vaccination plan can receive the vaccine now.

Homecare workers, personal support workers, and personal care attendants, along with the people they support, are eligible to receive vaccinations now at vaccine clinics statewide.

In most counties, Local Public Health Authorities (LPHAs) are working with your local offices to communicate information about upcoming clinics. Local offices, such as your CDDP, Brokerage, and APD/AAA, will share information about vaccine clinics when it's available. The Oregon Home Care Commission will communicate directly with you by email and social media when we have information about clinics in your communities.
