APD will be conducting surveys for these care settings to gather the following information:

- Identify which care settings are most at risk due to staffing shortages and what supports may be needed
- Provide opportunities for administrators to share policy ideas and potential solutions APD can consider to assist with staffing challenges
- Be aware of any care settings that have Medicaid bed openings
