## Message:

<u>Brain Rehab Network Oregon</u> (previously known as Kampfe Management Services) specializes in providing in-home supportive services for up to a 6-month period to help consumers who have recently experienced a severe brain injury, to live more independently. Effective August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, the Specialized Living Program contract with Brain Rehab Network Oregon has been amended.

Some of the changes made to the Statement of Work (SoW) in the specialized living contract include:

- · Clarification on eligibility and admission criteria;
- A better description of the referral and admissions process;
  - This includes a Contractor Referral form and the requirement of Central Office approval prior to move in.
- Addition of a more collaborative Person-Centered Service planning process between the Contractor, Consumer and Case Manager (CM); and
- A description of supportive services focused on training and supporting a consumer to live more independently. This is in addition to supports for Activities of Daily Living (ADL's) and Instrumental Activities of Daily Living (IADL's).

The rate for Brain Rehab Network Oregon has also changed from a single rate of payment to a 3-tiered rate system. The rates will vary based on the consumer's needs as identified in the CA/PS assessment and Brain Rehab Network Oregon's Assessment tool. The new rates are as follows:

- Long term care or 6-month base rate: \$7,500 prorated per month per consumer;
   or
- 6- month rehabilitation rates:
  - Minimal level of care scoring 161-200 (per the assessment tool) = \$9,000.00 per month per consumer.
  - Medium level of care scoring 100-160 (per the assessment tool) = \$12,000.00 per month per consumer.

The updated SoW and Contractor Referral form can be found on CM Tools > Programs & Services> Specialized Living Program. CMs are encouraged to review the updated SoW and the referral form.

Contact Brain Rehab Network Oregon for any interested consumers that may benefit from their services. Brain Rehab Network Oregon is establishing a point of contact for CMs. This information will be added to CM tools with the SoW once provided.
