Per <u>APD-PT-22-020</u>, Home Delivered Meals (HDM) is now an allowable service under State Plan Personal Care (SPPC), effective July 1, 2022. However, the CEP voucher system in the mainframe did not allow this type of authorization.

Retroactive to July 1, 2022, the mainframe has been updated to allow HDM authorizations for individuals receiving SPPC. Central Office is processing the HDM invoices that were submitted to <u>APD.Invoices@dhsoha.state.or.us</u> in the mainframe.

Starting with the November 2022 authorizations, staff will need to issue HDM vouchers for individuals receiving SPPC and HDM services. Please let HDM providers know they will now receive vouchers. Local offices should no longer forward HDM invoices to the APD Invoices box.
