As part of APD's equity work there is an expectation that all APD consumers have meaningful language access to APD services and benefits. All APD consumers have a right to receive communication in their preferred language. Ukrainian community leaders reported ongoing concerns that Ukrainian consumers were provided with communication in Russian even after they stated that their preferred language was Ukrainian. Upon investigation, it was discovered that there was no Ukrainian language drop-down in Oregon Access (OA). To remedy this and to prevent causing additional trauma for Ukrainians fleeing the war with Russia, Ukrainian language drop-down was added to Oregon Access (OA) and is now available to use.

Please review cases that have Ukrainian consumers and update their preferred language in Oregon Access (OA) according to their wishes.
