**Message:**

Aging and People with Disability (APD) Central Office (CO) has identified the need to define the terminology used when describing the services offered by APD. This effort will help staff effectively communicate what programs and services are offered by APD and identify the differences.

The following terminology reflects the services offered by APD:

- APD Services
  - APD Services incorporates all APD programs which provide assistance to an individual in their home or community. Commonly referred to as Home and Community Based Services, or HCBS.
- Medicaid Long-term Services and Supports (LTSS)
  - Medicaid LTSS includes all services authorized under the 1915(k) waiver, 1915(c) waiver, Independent Choice Program (ICP) authorized under the 1915(j) waiver, and services provided by a Nursing Facility (NF). Commonly referred to as K-plan or Title XIX.
  - Oregon ACCESS (OA) Service plan benefits include:
    - In-home (APD/KPS)

- Residential (APD/KPS)
- PACE In-home & Residential
- ICP
- State Plan Personal Care (SPPC)
  - OA Service plan benefits include:
    - BPO
    - BPA
- Oregon Project Independence – Medicaid (OPI-M)
  - OPI-M is an expansion of the current state funded OPI program. Future communication will be released when this program becomes available.
  - OA Service plan benefits include;
    - OPI - Medicaid
- Oregon Project Independence (OPI)
  - A state funded program managed by Area Agency on Aging (AAA) offices.
  - OA Service plan benefits include:
    - OPI
