<u>Discussion/interpretation</u>: Effective March 1, 2020, the increase to the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) will increase the adjusted income standard for individuals in 24-hour mental health residential care settings.

The new income standard is \$1,595.00 for a need group of one.

Please note that mental health services in a 24-hour residential care setting are provided under the 1915(i) state plan option rather than under a waiver; however, individuals receiving 1915(i) services are considered a household, filing, financial, and need group of one, similar to those receiving other long-term services and supports (except SPPC).

This transmittal does not apply to those receiving up to 20 hours of state plan personal care mental health services (case descriptor BPM), as those individuals must be otherwise eligible for OHP Plus and are not subject to the 150% FPL income standard.

<u>Implementation/transition instructions</u>: Apply the new income standard when processing new applications and redeterminations for individuals receiving 1915(i) mental health services effective March 1, 2020.

<u>Training/communication plan</u>: Training materials will be updated to reflect the new standards.

<u>Local/branch action required</u>: Managers should discuss with staff in unit meetings.

<u>Central office action required</u>: Update policy manuals and training material and provide assistance when needed.
