#### **Discussion/interpretation:**

Effective July 1, 2021, the January 1 temporary rate increase, that took account for extraordinary expenses incurred by long term care providers as a result of the COVID-19 crisis, has been extended. The rate increase is for Assisted Living Facilities, Residential Care Facilities, Memory Care Facilities, In-Home Agencies, Specific Needs CBC Contracts, CBC ECOS and ECS Programs, Specialized Living Contracts, In-home Specialized Living Contracts and Nursing Facilities. The temporary rate increase is extended to March 31, 2022.

In addition to the above, effective July 1, 2021, the following rates will increase: Assisted Living Facilities, Residential Care Facilities, Memory Care Facilities, In-Home Care Agencies, Specific Needs CBC Contracts, CBC ECOS and ECS Programs, Specialized Living Contracts, In-home Specialized Living Contracts, Nursing Facilities, Home Delivered Meals and Long Term Care Community Nursing Services.
