Discussion/interpretation:

Homecare workers, personal support workers, and personal care attendants are required to complete 12 hours of continuing education training every 24 months. These training requirements align with the end-date of the provider's approved to work credential.

OAR 418-020-0035 has been amended to change the continuing education implementation date from Sept. 1, 2023, to March 1, 2026. The implementation date

has been extended to develop a more robust catalogue of training options based on provider type and the specific needs of individuals receiving services and allow providers sufficient time to fulfill training requirements.

Carewell SEIU 503 Training launched continuing education courses online in April 2023. Providers who complete these courses between April 1, 2023, and March 1, 2026, will receive training credit when continuing education requirements are implemented March1, 2026.

Providers will receive a stipend from Carewell SEIU 503 Training once they complete all 12 hours.

Providers are encouraged to begin taking continuing education courses now and can do so by logging into the <u>Carewell's learning portal</u>.
