## Action required:

In compliance with federal and state reporting requirements, case management entities must implement use of the <u>427 Civil Commitment Worker Guide</u> for all civil commitment processes under ORS 427.

## Reason for action:

ORS 427 delegates civil commitment responsibility to the Oregon Department of Human Services (ODHS), Office of Developmental Disabilities and Community Developmental Disabilities Program (CDDP) offices. Oregon enacted ORS 181A.290 to comply with the Brady Handgun Violence Prevention Act, which established the National Instant Check System (NICS). This requires minimum necessary information to be provided by ODHS to the Oregon Department of the State Police (OSP) regarding individuals who are committed to the Department. OSP updates the Federal Bureau of Investigation, which maintains NICS updates and assures accurate information requiring federally licensed gun dealers to confirm with the NICS an individual is not prohibited from possessing a firearm prior to transferring a firearm to an individual. Consistency in practices and standard operating procedures are necessary for interagency requirements, accuracy and appropriate outcomes related to civil commitments under ORS 427. The <u>427 Civil Commitment Worker Guide</u> establishes expectations and steps for CDDP's to follow when needing to proceed with a 427 commitment.
