Discussion/interpretation:

Updated:

- Added clarification that the most recent ANA/CNA sets the minimum service level; it may not have occurred in 2023 as implied in the original.

- Edited to show that the description of mid-year changes in service groups applies only after the ISP renews in 2024.
- Added information about how changes in age affect service group assignment.
- Added information about the duration of staffing ratio exceptions.

ODDS released a new worker guide related to Oregon's maintenance of effort obligations related to the American Rescue Plan Act. When the state of Oregon accepted funds under the federal ARPA, Oregon agreed not to reduce access to services and spending on services until at least March of 2025. Additionally, Oregon made an agreement with the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) that no individual's in-home hours would be reduced because of transitioning to the Oregon Needs Assessment (ONA) service group (SG) framework for hour allocation until after March of 2025. These agreements are called Maintenance of Effort (MOE). This guide provides instructions and resources to transition to use service groups for in-home hours allocation while meeting the obligation of the MOE.
