

## Process to Obtaining Pre-Employment Transition Services (Pre-ETS) for Students Age 14-21 with Disabilities

Student 14 to 21 years old	• The age a student with a disability may receive Pre-Employment Transition Services (Pre-ETS).
Explore Pre-Employment Transition Services	<ul> <li>Pre-ETS are individualized, free, requested services dependent on the needs of the student, classroom, or school district.</li> <li>Pre-ETS categories are Job Exploration Counseling, Counseling on Post Secondary Education and/or Transition Services, Workplace Readiness, Work Based Learning, Instruction in Self-Advocacy.</li> </ul>
Fill out Request for Consultation Form (form 1723)	<ul><li> The first step is to request services.</li><li> If the student is under 18, a parent or guardian must sign the form.</li></ul>
Email form to Pre-ETS email	<ul> <li>You may fax, mail or drop off the form in person.</li> <li>The most timely way to send in the form is to email: <a href="mailto:Pre.ETS@odhsoha.oregon.gov">Pre.ETS@odhsoha.oregon.gov</a></li> </ul>
Student meets requirements	<ul> <li>Student must be verified (as a student with a disability) prior to the service provided.</li> <li>Student does not have to be enrolled in Vocational Rehabilitation to receive Pre-ETS.</li> </ul>
Pre-ETS provider is assigned to your student	• Pre-ETS providers are: Pre-ETS Coordinators, Transition Network Facilitators, Pre-ETS Support Specialists, YTP Specialist, or VR Counselor, depending on region and school.
Pre-ETS consult and service provided	<ul><li> The Pre-ETS provider will contact student for a consultation.</li><li> Services are based on the student need.</li></ul>
