

Data Reporting Requirements - ADA Price Agreement Consultant Projects

Purpose:

The ADA Program oversees production of curb ramps and pushbuttons for pedestrian signals throughout Oregon. To document our progress, we need basic data on a ramp-by-ramp basis with consistent updates.

For ADA curb ramp-only projects delivered via ADA Price Agreement contracts, the following applies:

Data Entry Tool:

The program currently uses a statewide GIS database for PA consultant projects. If you have recent or current work with the program, you should have access via your consultant specific web application. After any new WOC award, please confirm with the contact below that the new locations are being added to your web application to allow editing, or if you need login access to your firm's application.

Minimum Data Fields:

Please see <u>Statewide ADA Ramp Assessment Project Data Key</u> for required minimum data fields. The required fields are shown by ***Data Field Name*** in the key.

Frequency of Update:

With the high volume of ramps programmed into these projects, the ADA program wants to ensure that updates are timely for reporting purposes. We require consultants to provide monthly updates through the statewide GIS database or communicate with the contact listed below if no change.

We are committed to keeping data tracking to a minimum, but as the program evolves, we may change the frequency and data we track.
