

Instructions for DBE Commitment Requirements

Notice to Bidders

If set DBE Goal is not reached, all bids must be submitted with documented Good Faith Efforts (GFE) is required for all bidders on all Federal-Aid Projects.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL DEEM YOUR BID NON-RESPONSIVE

There are two ways to submit a responsive bid. The following outlines instructions for each.
