



What does this mean on our Construction Projects?



- AWP will be implemented for **new projects only** (no historical data)
- Work will happen in AWP and Doc Express
- Spec changes and special provisions 170.09
- Contractor/Subcontractors/Technicians will be adding data to AWP
- ODOT manages Access, Roles, and Permissions
- No cost for Contractors or Consultants
- Payments are through AWP

Training




Get Ready:

All companies **MUST** register in OregonBuys.
This includes consultants, contractors and subcontractors.



Just In Time Training:

Project trainers will provide on site initial training right before project work begins. This means you apply what you learn right away to reinforce your learning.



Training Attendance:

Training will be in person at or near the RE or consultant office that project is assigned to. Bring your laptops and other devices to training. We will have some options for those that are far away to join through Teams.




After training:
