INSPECTOR CERTIFICATIONS

Challenge exam events are currently not available for inspector certifications due to COVID Restrictions. We will announce when we are able to open challenge events in the future.

ADA Certification

<i>Extensions</i>	No further extensions will be given other than those already provided to the individuals who took the ADA Training in 2020.
<i>Training</i>	This class has been converted into a Pass/Fail self-guided course. Once an individual has passed this course they will receive a one-year certification. This course will be available through iLearn on February 1 st .
<i>New Certifications</i>	Not applicable since training is being made available for this class.

Certified Asphalt Pavement Inspector (ACPI)

<i>Extensions</i>	There will be no extensions offered for this certification.
<i>Training</i>	There will be three virtual real-time classes. Attending the virtual class will provide a one-year certification for the participant. This will be extended to the full five years once the participant takes and passes the exam. Information regarding exam events will be sent out to participants of virtual classes. Certified Drilled Shaft Inspector (CDSI)

Certified General Construction Inspector (CGCI)

<i>Training</i>	There will be three virtual classes. Attending the virtual class will provide a one-year certification for the participant. OTHER CERTIFICATIONS	
Erosion and Sediment Control Manager (ESCM)	
<i>Extensions</i>	There will be extensions for those currently certified or that will expired in 2021. All extensions will be extended through December 31, 2021.
<i>Training</i>	This training is currently being developed as a self-guided on-line class. It is planned to offer this class in the spring through iLearn. A notification will be sent when the self-guided online training is available.
<i>New Certifications</i>	Not applicable since the training will be on-line. However, individuals who have attended any of the training approved by DEQ are considered eligible to be an Erosion and Sediment Control Manager. The DEQ approved training includes: a) certified professional in Erosion and Sediment Control; b) certified personnel in storm water quality; c) certified inspector of Sediment and Erosion Control; d) Washington State Certified Erosion and Sediment Control Lead (CESCL); or e) Rogue Valley Sewer Services Erosion and Sediment Control Certification.
Traffic Control Supervisor/Technician (TCST)	
<i>Extensions</i>	There will be no extensions offered for this certification.
<i>Training</i>	This training is virtual. Several full and recertification classes have been set up. A full three year certification will be provided after successful completion of the requirements for this certification.
