

DMV, how do I **change my address** online?


We are glad you asked! Making sure that DMV has your correct address helps us keep you informed about upcoming vehicle and card expirations—and it's the law. Changing your address is easy to do at DMV2U.

What you'll need:

- Your current address
- Your new physical and/or mailing address
- Your Oregon Driver License, Permit or Identification Card

Follow these easy steps:

1. Go to dmv2u.oregon.gov
2. Click on **Report an address change** in the Notify the DMV section of the page (see example).
3. Read the information under Personal Address Change, then click **Online now**. Enter your **Driver License, Permit or Identification Card Number**. Enter your **Date of Birth**.
4. Enter your current **Zip Code**.
5. Then click **Continue**. Enter your new **Address, City, State** and **Zip Code**. Follow the Voter Information instructions. Be sure to let us know if your mailing address is the same or different from your physical residence address using the yellow highlighted area (see example).
6. Once you have reviewed your information, click **Continue**.
7. DMV will verify the information by using US Post Office data. You will have an opportunity to review and confirm, or edit, your new address information.
8. If everything looks correct, click **Submit** and you are done!

Note: Changing your address in our system is free, and you are not required to purchase a replacement card. DMV does not issue address stickers for your driver license, permit or ID card. Visit your local [DMV office](#), to apply and pay for a replacement [license](#) or [ID card](#) showing your new address. The fee to replace license or permit is \$26.00, and an ID card is \$39.50.
