ARE YOU **REAL ID** READY?

- As of May 2025, anyone 18 and older must show federally accepted identification to board a plane for U.S. flights.
- A state-issued driver's license or ID card with the REAL ID option meets federal requirements. To get one, you must present extra documentation at a DMV office.
- Any government-issued passport is an acceptable form of ID.
- If you are traveling outside the U.S., including Canada and Mexico, you will still need a passport.
- A REAL ID Oregon driver's license or ID card has a star inside a black circle in the upper right corner.
