Congressional Medal of Honor

Along with all other requirements, you must provide:

- A letter from the U.S. Department of Veterans’ Affairs certifying you were awarded the U.S. Congressional Medal of Honor.

**You may be able to reduce your registration fees by enrolling in [OREGO](#). [Contact DMV](#) for fees if you are enrolled. If you leave the OReGO program, DMV will bill you for the full registration fee.

For help with your vehicle’s combined MPG rating, check fuelconomy.gov. DMV records may not match, but we will contact you if we need more fees or if you are due a refund.

Disabled Veteran

These plates cannot be used to park in Disabled Person Parking spaces.

Disabled Veteran registration is permanent. A qualifying veteran can only have one plate or set of plates. Any vehicle that can be registered may get disabled veteran plates **except**:

- Low-speed;
- Medium-speed; and
- Commercial vehicles.



Along with all other requirements, you must provide:

- Proof that you have a service-connected disability; and
- A completed [Application for Disabled Veteran Plates](#).

Ex-POW

Ex-POW registration is permanent. Only one motor vehicle per qualifying veteran per household can have Ex-POW plates. Any motor vehicle that can be registered may get Ex-POW plates **except**:

- Low-speed;
- Medium-speed;
- Vehicles with a combined or loaded weight over 10,000 pounds; and
- Commercial vehicles.



Along with all other requirements, you must provide:

- Proof of your qualifying POW status; and
- A completed [Ex-POW Certification](#).

First Marine Division FMF

Along with all other requirements, you must provide:

- Proof of your qualifying First Marine Division status; and
- A completed [Group Plate Certification](#).

The fee chart includes the \$10 or \$20 First Marine Division FMF plate fee, which supports the Oregon Chapter of the First Marine Division. These plates are assigned a random 4-letter plate number, they cannot be customized. **See page 5 to calculate your total fee.**



Gold Star Family

Along with all other requirements, you must:

- Be a parent, sibling, spouse or dependent of a person killed in action; and
- Provide a completed [Group Plate Certification](#).

The fee chart includes the \$10 or \$20 Gold Star Family plate fee, which supports the Vietnam Veterans of America, Oregon State Council. These plates are assigned a random 4-letter plate number, they cannot be customized. **See page 5 to calculate your total fee.**



Purple Heart

Along with all other requirements, you must provide:

- Proof you were awarded the Purple Heart medal; and
- A completed [Group Plate Certification](#).

The fee chart includes the \$10 or \$20 Purple Heart plate fee, which supports the Oregon Military Order of the Purple Heart. These plates are assigned a random 4-letter plate number, they cannot be customized. **See page 5 to calculate your total fee.**



U.S. Army Special Forces Airborne

Along with all other requirements, you must provide:

- Proof of honorable discharge;
- Proof of award of Special Forces qualifications; and
- A completed [Group Plate Certification](#).

The fee chart includes the \$10 or \$20 U.S. Army Special Forces Airborne plate fee, which supports the Oregon Veterans Home Trust. These plates are assigned a random 4-letter plate number, they cannot be customized. **See page 5 to calculate your total fee.**



Veterans' Recognition

Along with all other requirements, you must provide:

- Proof of honorable discharge;
- Proof of awarded medal, if requesting a medal; and
- A completed [Veterans' Recognition Application](#).

The fee chart includes the \$10 or \$20 Veterans' Recognition plate fee, which supports the Oregon Veterans Home Trust. These plates are assigned a random 4-letter plate number, they cannot be customized. You can choose a blank plate (pictured), an insignia, or medal, see page 4 for plate options. **See page 5 to calculate your total fee.**



If you choose the blank plate (pictured), you cannot put your own sticker or decal in the blank space on the plate.
