## Oregon Certified Public Road Mileage

The table below shows the State of Oregon's Certified Public Mileage since 1960. The Federal Highway Administration defines a public road as: "Roads under the jurisdiction of and maintained by a public authority which are open to travel by 2 wheel drive passenger vehicles" (paraphrased)<sup>1</sup>.
