Coos County Pilot Vehicle Requirements

All loads over 8'06" in width and all unladen heavy haul operations require one front pilot vehicle.

Coos County Approved Route List

Truck-Tractor Semitrailer Combinations may operate at a maximum of 75 feet in overall length on all county highways, except as described above.

Double Trailer Combinations may operate at a maximum of 75 feet in overall length on all county highways, except as described above.

Truck and Trailers Combinations may operate at a maximum of 75 feet in overall length on all county highways, except as described above.

- **The maximum length of a semitrailer in a truck tractor semitrailer combination is 53 feet.**
- **The maximum length of a semitrailer in a truck tractor semitrailer trailer combination (doubles) is 40 feet. The distance measured from the front trailer to the rear trailer cannot exceed 68 feet.**
