# **Coos County Road Restrictions**

Highway	Section	Restriction
Gaylord Road	All	No oversize or overweight loads
Seven Devils Road	Gravel portion	No oversize or overweight loads
Shinglehouse Road	All	No oversize or overweight loads

### **Coos County Pilot Vehicle Requirements**

All loads over 8'06" in width and all unladen heavy haul operations require one front pilot vehicle.

### **Coos County Approved Route List**

Truck-Tractor Semitrailer Combinations may operate at a maximum of 75 feet in overall length on all county highways, except as described above.

**Double Trailer Combinations** may operate at a maximum of 75 feet in overall length on all county highways, except as described above.

Truck and Trailers Combinations may operate at a maximum of 75 feet in overall length on all county highways, except as described above.

- The maximum length of a semitrailer in a truck tractor semitrailer combination is 53 feet.
- The maximum length of a semitrailer in a truck tractor semitrailer trailer combination (doubles) is 40 feet. The distance measured from the front trailer to the rear trailer cannot exceed 68 feet.
