

Mileage Tax Rates

Effective July 01, 2027

Instructions For Table A

To compute the tax, select the weight group that includes the registered weight of your vehicle for the State of Oregon as listed in the vehicle's registration document for the tax reporting period. Multiply your Oregon taxable miles times the rate listed for the weight group to calculate the amount of tax due. Taxable miles in Oregon includes all miles driven in Oregon on roads accessible to the public. If returning empty, use the same weight and rate as when loaded.

You may claim a credit if you paid Oregon state fuel tax on fuel for a vehicle subject to weight-mile tax. The deduction must be for the reporting period that you used the fuel. Credits for previous reporting periods will not be granted until time of audit. You must attach copies of fuel invoices to the weight-mile tax report.

Column A Weight Group	Column B Mills Per Mile (1/10 of 1 Cent)	Column C Dollars Per Mile * Decimal Fraction
26,001 – 32,000	76.4	.0764
32,001 – 38,000	89.8	.0898
38,001 – 44,000	102.7	.1027
44,001 – 50,000	114.3	.1143
50,001 – 56,000	132.5	.1325
56,001 – 62,000	143.1	.1431
62,001 – 68,000	166.2	.1662
68,001 – 74,000	181.5	.1815
74,001 – 80,000	251.2	.2512
80,001 – 105,500	263.1	.2631

* **Note:** Column C converts mills per mile to dollars per mile by moving the decimal point three places to the left. Multiply the decimal fraction by the Oregon Taxable Miles for the amount of tax due for each weight.

Fee Computation Examples			
Column A	Column B	Column C	Example
32,000	76.4	.0764	1000 Miles x .0764 = \$ 76.40
80,000	251.2	.2512	100 Miles x .2512 = \$ 25.12
