Discussion Items

6. Local Construction Project Updates 16:10-23:15 Presenter: Mary Dillinger, ODOT

The Jackson County ADA projects have begun. There will be ADA ramps installed in various locations over Jackson County, throughout the rest of the year.

The Big X (OR238, OR99, and Hwy62) construction will be nightwork for the next few months. Improvements include pavement and bridge preservation, and bike/pedestrian/ADA ramp upgrades, this projects has 88 ADA ramp within the project. Completion is nearing.

The Foothill Rd Improvement project has been broken into different sections. The Jackon County section, Delta Waters to Dry Creek has been completed. The City of Medford section, Delta Waters, is an active construction zone, and is closed, with detours expected to reopen September 19th with local access only. The expected completion date is in 2026.

The Glenwood to Coleman project is part of the Almeda Fire rebuilding process. Construction began In November 2024, improving safety for pedestrians and cyclists. Expected to continue through 2025. Lane Shifts and closures to happen.

Wrong Way Driver, Quick moving project, Gage-it Construction doing work. Tasks, applying low-cost treatments, such as reflectors, and updated signage. Resuming September 15, 2025.

Barnett and Highlight (Exit 27)

OR 99 – Gold Hill Bridge – Kick off in 2026, after Gold Dust Days

OR 99- Glenwood to Matt loop, goes to bid end of 2025

I-5 Monument Drive to N. Grants Pass – starting soon

HWY 62 and OR 234 Roundabout -Open house end of July Successful, 50 attendees. Kick off in 2027. OR 140 and Leigh Way, adding a right Turn Lane. 2027 project.

- 7. Region and Budge Updates 23:17-1:03:27 Presenter: Darrin Neavoll, Region 3 manager, ODOT Darrin Presented on the current special sessions bill and timeline of events.
 - House approved HB3991 and HB3992: Revenue increases include, 6 cent/gallon gas tax going from \$.40 to \$.46 effective Jan 1, 2026
 - List of annual registration fees includes passenger vehicles, utility vehicles, light trailers, low speed vehicles and medium speed electric vehicles, along with mopeds and motorcycles.
 - Title fees for passenger vehicles also increase
 - Increase in registration surcharges for electric and highly fuel-efficient vehicles
 - Phasing in a mandatory road usage charge program by 2031 required for all EV and hybrid vehicles
 - Increase in payroll tax (0.1% to .02%) for public transportation effective Jan 1, 2026, to Jan 1, 2028 when it would revert to the 0.1%

Darrin also spoke of the impacts of the passing bill and the downfalls should it not pass in the senate. Provided what that would look like for road maintenance and winter impacts and service levels.
