I reviewed it briefly and have a few comments/suggestions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. pseudo-seizures is an outdated/antiquated term that is no longer used (sort of similar to calling a person of Asian descent "Oriental"). A more updated term would be "Functional Neurologic Symptom Disorder" with non-epileptic or functional dissociative seizures. I know it's wordy. Here's how I might put it down on paper:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• - Non-epileptic events (Functional Neurologic Symptom Disorder)</li></ul></li><li>2. For those in the "Low Risk" category for seizures, I would consider adding:<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. seizures that occur exclusively during sleep</li><li>b. patients in whom there is a prolonged warning prior to seizures, allowing the driver to discontinue driving safely</li></ol></li></ol> <p>Thank you again!
