

**Resolution to Amend the Oregon Highway Plan  
And Transfer Jurisdiction of Unit A of Cornelius Pass Highway, State  
Highway Number 127 Mile Point 0.00 to 4.09  
Jurisdictional Transfer No. 845**

WHEREAS the Oregon Department of Transportation and Multnomah County entered into a Jurisdictional Transfer Agreement No. 845 on December 28, 2020 where the Parties agreed that upon approval of a Jurisdictional Transfer Resolution by the Oregon Transportation Commission (OTC), the jurisdiction over Unit A of Cornelius Pass Highway, State Highway Number 127 from MP 0.00 to MP 4.09 would be transferred from Multnomah County to the Department of Transportation.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THIS COMMISSION:

1. Unit A of the Cornelius Pass Highway, State Highway No. 127 Mile Point 0.00 to 4.09 located in Multnomah County, Oregon and identified in Exhibit A, attached hereto and shown on the Exhibit B map attached hereto, is no longer needed by Multnomah County as part of the County's road system.
2. In accordance with 23 CFR 620, FHWA has given their concurrence with this Jurisdictional Transfer to proceed as of November 9, 2020.
3. The jurisdiction of this segment is transferred to Oregon Department of Transportation effective on the date of this resolution.
4. The 2017 Oregon Legislature directed ODOT to accept Cornelius Pass Road from Highway 30 to County line section in Multnomah County. This transfer was approved by the Legislature in House Bill 2017. The Oregon Transportation Commission will solicit comments on the transfer at a regular meeting in January 2021.
5. Notice of the transfer was emailed to the Department of Land Conservation and Development on January 21, 2020.
6. The Department shall post the Amendment on the Registry of Oregon Highway Plan Amendments.
