

**AMENDMENT NUMBER 01  
OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT)  
IN COOPERATION WITH THE  
ASSOCIATION OF OREGON COUNTIES AND THE LEAGUE OF OREGON CITIES  
FEDERAL-AID PROJECT  
GUIDELINES AND WORKING AGREEMENT**

This is Amendment No. 01 to the Agreement between the **State of Oregon**, acting by and through its Department of Transportation, hereinafter referred to as “State” or “ODOT,”; the Association of Oregon Counties, hereinafter referred to as “AOC,” and the League of Oregon Cities, hereinafter referred to as “LOC,” both AOC and LOC are governmental agencies, all hereinafter referred to as “Party” and collectively as the “Parties” entered into on November 22, 2026.

It has now been determined by State and Parties that the Agreement referenced above shall be amended to extend the effective date. The Parties anticipate a new federal transportation authorization to be enacted in September 2026. This extension will allow the parties to draft a new agreement to include the new authorization and any additional changes.

1. **Effective Date.** This Amendment shall become effective on the date it is fully executed and approved as required by applicable law.

2. **Amendment to Agreement.**

a. **SECTION 2, GENERAL TERMS, Paragraph d, Page 2, which reads:**

d. This Agreement shall become effective on the date all required signatures are obtained and shall remain in effect until September 30th, 2026.

**Shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:**

d. This Agreement shall become effective on the date all required signatures are obtained and shall remain in effect until September 30th, 2027.


3. **Counterparts.** This Amendment may be executed in two or more counterparts (by facsimile or otherwise) each of which is an original and all of which when taken together are deemed one agreement binding on all Parties, notwithstanding that all Parties are not signatories to the same counterpart.

4. **Original Agreement.** Except as expressly amended above, all other terms and conditions of the original Agreement are still in full force and effect. Parties certify that the representations, warranties and certifications in the original Agreement are true and correct as of the effective date of this Amendment and with the same effect as though made at the time of this Amendment.

5. **Electronic Signatures.** The Parties agree that signatures showing on PDF documents, including but not limited to PDF copies of the Agreement and amendments, submitted or exchanged via email are “Electronic Signatures” under ORS Chapter 84 and bind the signing Party and are intended to be and can be relied upon by the Parties. State reserves the right at any time to require the submission of the hard copy originals of any documents.


