DEBRIS CLEANUP AT-A-GLANCE: TIMELINE AND FUNDING

This document provides a high-level timeline of work accomplished to date and what's underway, and a snapshot of funding for the overall debris removal cleanup operation.

SEPTEMBER 2020

Labor Day Wildfires constitute the largest and most expensive disaster in Oregon history.

Debris Management Task Force quickly formed, comprised of OEM, DEQ, ODOT with federal assistance from EPA to help remove hazardous waste, hazard trees, and debris from communities.

OCTOBER 2020

Task force kicks off Step 1 work with EPA to remove hazardous waste from wildfire impacted properties.

Emergency contracting process begins for quickly hiring crews to monitor and remove hazard trees, ash, and debris.

NOVEMBER 2020

Step 1 work finishes. Hazards removed from 2285 properties in 8 Oregon counties.

Emergency contract process continues. Outreach with property owners, county partners, and communities happens throughout. Staff expertise hired for duration of the operation.

DECEMBER 2020

Emergency contract process concludes. Crews in place. Private Property Debris Removal Questionnaire mailed, emailed, and available online. Interactive progress map launched. New webpage posted. Step 2 work—removal of hazard trees, ash, debris—begins.

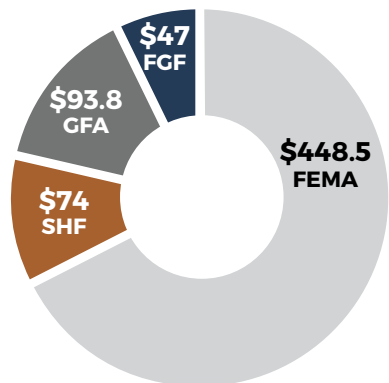
JANUARY 2021

Step 2 work continues and underway. In total, 32 contracts awarded in a two-month period.

JANUARY-SUMMER 2022

Statewide work estimated to be complete by summer 2022.
