




## Oregon Entry Policy — Over-Dimension Loads Get a Permit Before Operating In Oregon

Telephone Service is available Monday through Friday.

7 a.m. to 5 p.m. (Pacific Time)

**Exceptions:** Closed for all State holidays.

Closed 12 p.m. to 1 p.m. on Wednesdays for staff meeting.

### When Operation Originates in Oregon

Carriers must get variance permits **BEFORE** operation.

### When Operation Originates Outside of Oregon

Carriers must get variance permits **BEFORE** entry.

**Exception:** When entering Oregon on I-5 SB at the OR/WA Border, the carrier is allowed to go directly to Jantzen Beach/Portland Bridge Office to get necessary credentials. - Drivers will be subject to a citation and fine when operating without a valid variance permit AND the load may not proceed until your driver possesses a valid variance permit.
