



Acceptable Methods of Filing Weight-Mile Tax Reports and IFTA Returns

ODOT's Commerce and Compliance Division (CCD) strives to provide excellent service to all of our customers. Following are two convenient, preferred methods for filing reports and returns:



Oregon Trucking Online

This program is free and available 24 hours a day 7 days a week! Visit [Oregon Trucking Online](#) (TOL) to sign up for a Personal Identification Number (PIN). There are many features available including: Oregon weight-mile tax program, temporary passes, renewals, filing weight-mile tax reports and IFTA returns, making payments on your account, etc. Payments are made on our secure site using MasterCard or Visa.

Reports and Returns processed through TOL before midnight on the:

- Due date are considered timely and not assessed a late fee.
- Suspension date allows you to avoid suspension of your account.

Reports and Returns (with payment when applicable):

- Stamped with a postmark by the postal service by the due date are considered timely and not assessed a late fee.
- Received by CCD on or before the suspension date allows you to avoid the suspension of your account.

Make your payment by company check, cashier's check or money order. We are not able to process credit cards for mailed-in transactions and do not accept faxed reports at this time.
