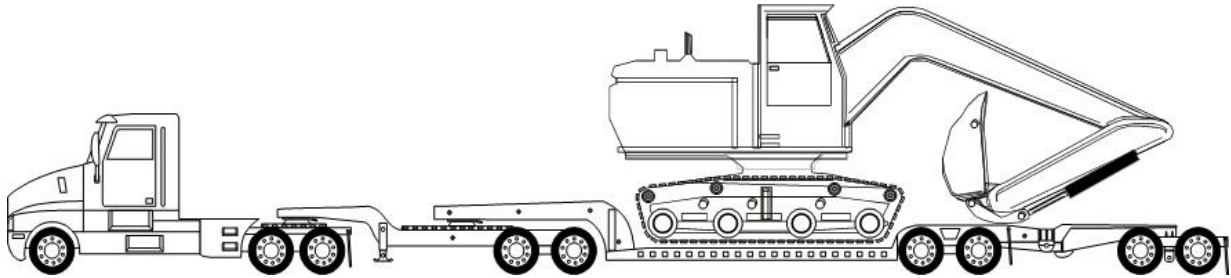


Holiday Schedule 2021/2022

Non-Divisible Loads

The following holidays have specific restrictions for non-divisible loads.



Memorial Day – Observed Monday, May 31, 2021

No movement if over 8 feet 6 inches wide from Noon Friday, May 28 until 1/2 hour before sunrise Tuesday, June 1.

EXCEPTION *

Beginning at 12:01 a.m. Tuesday, June 1, loads up to 10 feet in width may travel at night on highways shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#) and up to 12 feet in width on Interstate Highways.

EXCEPTIONS to Holiday Weekend Travel Restrictions

When the overall width does not exceed 14 feet for non-divisible loads:

- Movement is allowed from 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset Saturday, May 29 and Sunday, May 30 on:
 - Interstate Highways.
 - US97.
 - Any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#).
- Loads may travel night from 12:01 a.m. Saturday, May 29 to 12 Midnight Sunday, May 30 at the following dimensions on the following routes*:
 - Up to 12 feet in width on Interstate Highways.
 - Up to 10 feet in width on US97 and any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) AND which shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#).

Note: No Overwidth Movement Allowed after 12 Noon on Friday, May 28 or all day Monday, May 31.

Independence Day – Observed Monday, July 5, 2021

No movement if over 8 feet 6 inches wide from Noon Friday, July 2 until 1/2 hour before sunrise Tuesday, July 6.

EXCEPTION *

Beginning at 12:01 a.m. Tuesday, July 6, loads up to 10 feet in width may travel at night on highways shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#) and up to 12 feet in width on Interstate Highways.

EXCEPTIONS to Holiday Weekend Travel Restrictions

When the overall width does not exceed 14 feet for non-divisible loads:

- Movement is allowed from 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset Saturday, July 3 and Sunday, July 4 on:
 - Interstate Highways.
 - US97.
 - Any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#).
- Loads may travel night from 12:01 a.m. Saturday, July 3 to 12 Midnight Sunday, July 4 at the following dimensions on the following routes*:
 - Up to 12 feet in width on Interstate Highways.
 - Up to 10 feet in width on US97 and any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) AND which shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#).

Note: No Overwidth Movement Allowed after 12 Noon on Friday, July 2 or all day Monday, July 5.

Labor Day – Observed Monday, September 6, 2021

No movement if over 8 feet 6 inches wide from Noon Friday, September 3 until 1/2 hour before sunrise Tuesday, September 7.

EXCEPTION *

Beginning at 12:01 a.m. Tuesday, September 7, loads up to 10 feet in width may travel at night on highways shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#) and up to 12 feet in width on Interstate Highways.

EXCEPTIONS to Holiday Weekend Travel Restrictions

When the overall width does not exceed 14 feet for non-divisible loads:

- Movement is allowed from 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset Saturday, September 4 and Sunday, September 5 on:
 - Interstate Highways.
 - US97.
 - Any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#).
- Loads may travel night from 12:01 a.m. Saturday, September 4 to 12 Midnight Sunday, September 5 at the following dimensions on the following routes*:
 - Up to 12 feet in width on Interstate Highways.
 - Up to 10 feet in width on US97 and any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) AND which shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#).

Note: No Overwidth Movement Allowed after 12 Noon on Friday, September 3 or all day Monday, September 6.

Thanksgiving – Observed Thursday and Friday, November 25-26, 2021

No movement if over 8 feet 6 inches wide from Noon Wednesday, November 24 until 1/2 hour before sunrise Monday, November 29.

EXCEPTION *

Beginning at 12:01 a.m. Monday, November 29, loads up to 10 feet in width may travel at night on highways shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#) and up to 12 feet in width on Interstate Highways.

EXCEPTIONS to Holiday Weekend Travel Restrictions

When the overall width does not exceed 14 feet for non-divisible loads:

- Movement is allowed from 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset Thursday, November 25, Friday, November 26 and Saturday, November 27 on:
 - Interstate Highways.
 - US97.
 - Any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#).
- Loads may travel at night from 12:01 a.m. Thursday, November 25 to 12 Midnight Saturday, November 27 at the following dimensions on the following routes*:
 - Up to 12 feet in width on Interstate Highways.
 - Up to 10 feet in width on US97 and any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) AND shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#).

Note: No Overwidth Movement Allowed after 12 Noon on Wednesday, November 24 or all day Sunday, November 28.

Christmas – Observed Friday, December 24, 2021

No movement if over 8 feet 6 inches wide from Noon Thursday, December 23 until 1/2 hour before sunrise Monday, December 27.

EXCEPTION *

Beginning at 12:01 a.m. Monday, December 27, loads up to 10 feet in width may travel at night on highways shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#) and up to 12 feet in width on Interstate Highways.

EXCEPTIONS to Holiday Weekend Travel Restrictions

When the overall width does not exceed 14 feet for non-divisible loads:

- Movement is allowed from 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset Friday, December 24 and Saturday, December 25:
 - Interstate Highways.
 - US97.
 - Any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#).
- Loads may travel night from 12:01 a.m. Friday, December 24 to 12 Midnight Saturday, December 25 at the following dimensions on the following routes*:
 - Up to 12 feet in width on Interstate Highways.
 - Up to 10 feet in width on US97 and any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) AND which shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#).

Note: No Overwidth Movement Allowed after 12 Noon on Thursday, December 23 or all day Sunday, December 26.

New Year's Day 2022 - Observed Friday, December 31, 2021

No movement if over 8 feet 6 inches wide from Noon Thursday, December 30, 2021 until 1/2 hour before sunrise Monday, January 3, 2022.

EXCEPTION *

Beginning at 12:01 a.m. Monday, January 3, loads up to 10 feet in width may travel at night on highways shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#) and up to 12 feet in width on Interstate Highways.

EXCEPTIONS to Holiday Weekend Travel Restrictions

When the overall width does not exceed 14 feet for non-divisible loads:

- Movement is allowed from 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset Friday, December 31, 2021 and Saturday, January 1, 2022:
 - Interstate Highways.
 - US97.
 - Any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#).
- Loads may travel night from 12:01 a.m. Friday, December 31 to 12 Midnight Saturday, January 1 at the following dimensions on the following routes*:
 - Up to 12 feet in width on Interstate Highways.
 - Up to 10 feet in width on US97 and any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) AND which shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#).

Note: No Overwidth Movement Allowed after 12 Noon on Thursday, December 30 or all day Sunday, January 2.

*When operating during the hours of darkness, the outermost extremities must be illuminated by lamps or markers as described by the requirements of [ORS Chapter 816](#) and [FMCSR Chapter 393](#), in addition to all other lighting and warning sign requirements described in [OAR Chapter 734, Division 75](#).

State Observed Holidays Not Travel Restricted

Martin Luther King, Jr. Day – Observed Monday, January 18, 2021.

President's Day – Observed Monday, February 15, 2021.

Veterans Day – Observed Thursday, November 11, 2021.
