

What, Why & Anticipated Benefits



WHAT: Replace the existing system with a selfservice online system. Procure a Custom Off-the-Shelf (COTS) system with expanded capabilities (automated routing)

WHY: To meet increasing permit demand and improve service levels. Reduce reliance on aging mainframe infrastructure

ANTICIPATED BENEFITS:

- Carrier self-service
- Greater access (24/7, 365 days/yr)
- Improved turnaround time
- Improved data collection and reporting
- Greater permit accuracy
- Increased safety and compliance
- Reduced risk to the infrastructure
- More time for all of us to focus on more complex permitting requests





Future State Process Flow – and your role!

Carrier Logs In and Requests Permit



Route is generated by the system based on known restrictions





Carriers submits payment for the permit

System generates the permit

- Counties will have their own have user accounts they can manage.
- System has county road/bridge data.
- System knows what is permittable for each county based on current agreements.
- System will notify counties when a permit needs their review via autogenerated email.
- Counties will login to review, approve, & specify provisions

 Reports will be available for Counties.

OD Permit System Replacement Project -County Partner Survey

ODOT's Commerce and Compliance Division is implementing a self-service online permitting system within the next two years. The new system will have automated routing capabilities and customers will be able to request permits 24/7. Counties are a valuable partner in ensuring the safe transport of large loads across the State of Oregon. Your input is critical to the success of this project.

NOTE: ODOT is currently authorized to permit on County Roads through existing Blanket Agreements.

None of that will change. Permits that require County approval will also be available through the new system but will be flagged for County review before issuance (similar to today's process).
