Over Dimension Permit System




ORION will replace the existing system to meet increasing permit demand, complexity, and improve service levels.





Single-trip permits will propose a suggested route that must be followed in the sequence shown on the permit. Actual operation under the authority of a single trip permit will establish that the Permittee has verified the adequacy of the suggested route. Therefore, it is required that the Permittee contact the

Over-Dimension Permit Unit to request changes deemed necessary to the suggested route prior to actual operation. The Permittee assumes all liability for any damages resulting from operations under the permit. Operation under the permit means the Permittee confirms the suggested route is appropriate and the Permittee assumes all liability for any damages resulting from operations under the permit.

Loads transported on drop deck trailers: When a load more than 40 feet in length extends more than 5 feet beyond the rear of the semitrailer, the load must be non-divisible in length and the length of the load must be specified on the permit. The load may be transported on the lower deck of a drop deck semitrailer and may extend beyond the rear of the trailer up to the length authorized by the permit. In addition to the load transported on the lower deck of a

- drop deck trailer, a load may be transported on the upper deck of the trailer providing the load does not exceed 14 feet in height or the height authorized by the permit. When an over-dimension permit authorizes a height exceeding 14 feet, the load on the upper deck may not exceed the height of the load on the lower deck, and must be non-divisible in height. When a divisible load is transported on the upper deck and the lower deck of a drop deck trailer, the weight shall not exceed Permit Weight Table 1 or 2 as authorized by the permit.
- Width over 11ft prohibited between 7-8am and 2-3pm on Aumsville Hwy/11th St.
