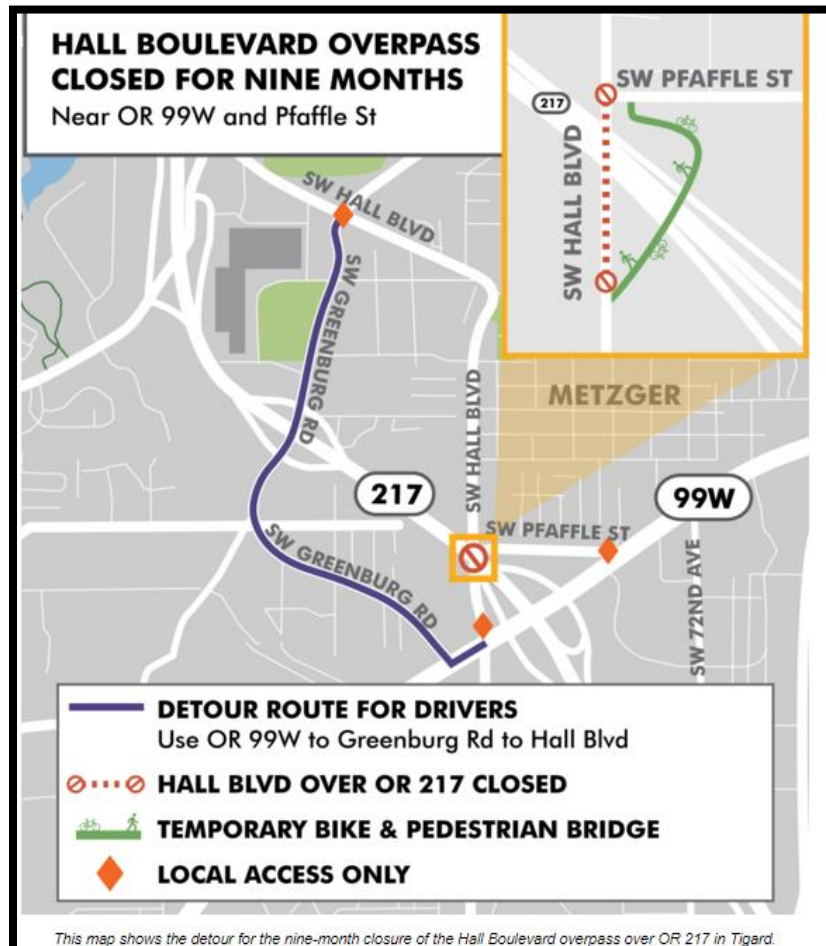

**Subject: Full Closures:** OR217 NB & SB MP 5.00 to MP 6.00 & OR141/Hall Blvd NB & SB MP 4.25 to MP 4.50 (Tigard)

Beginning March 15, 2024, this section of OR217 northbound and southbound, and all associated ramps, within the project’s work zone, will be closed all weekend starting Friday at 9:00 p.m. through Monday at 5:00 a.m. This closure is necessary to install a temporary pedestrian bridge span. Additionally, A full overnight closure of OR 217 at Hall Boulevard on Saturday, March 9 will take place.

Beginning on Friday, March 4, 2024. OR141/Hall Boulevard will be closed at all hours, starting at 9:00 p.m. This closure is necessary to complete the demolition and re-construction of the new OR141/Hall Boulevard. The estimated completion of this closure is November 10, 2024.



## Detour Route Information

When the full closure of OR217 (occurring on the weekend), is taking place, motor carriers can use US26 and I-5 to avoid the restricted area. When the full closure of OR141/Hall Boulevard is occurring motor carriers can use Greenburg Road and OR99W to avoid the restricted area, or other authorized alternative routes.

For questions or help with determining authorized alternate routes, please contact the Over-Dimension Permit Unit Monday-Friday between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. at 503-373-0000. Motor Carriers need to provide this information to their drivers, by copy of this letter or other means, to assure their awareness of the restriction.
