INTRODUCTION

This publication is designed to help department employees interpret entries on driving records when using the DD11 record inquiry program.

Entries on DMV driver/identification records are separated into two sections, as follows:

1. FIXED ENTRIES

Fixed entries generally include information we record for every record holder; such as name, address, and date of birth. This portion of the record also contains information about any identification card or Oregon driving privilege the person holds, as well as endorsements, restrictions and expiration dates.

2. VARIABLE ENTRIES

Variable entries are those that make up an individual's driving history; such as accidents, convictions, suspensions, revocations, cancellations and other administrative actions. Variable entries may also include information about the type(s) of license, permit, and/or endorsement the person holds (or has held in the past).

This manual is only for Oregon Department of Transportation employees who access driving records and <u>IS NOT</u> distributed to the public.

A similar manual for public use is The Guide to Oregon Driving Records and is available on-line at www.OregonDMV.com.

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Fixed entries on a driving record contain information about a driver (or ID card holder), license type, endorsements, and restrictions. Fixed entries are the first page of a driving record when using the DD11 inquiry program. Each individual field has been numbered for convenience. Section 2 contains the definitions of these fields (by number).

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Fixed entries are contained in the first page of a driving record when using the DD11 inquiry program. A sample of the fixed entries appearing on a driving record is shown in Section 1. Definitions of each individual field have been numbered for convenience.

- (1) Computer program number
- (2) Customer Number (Driver License, Permit, ID Card or file reference)
- (3) Date of birth (zeros if unknown)
- (4) Record page number
- **(5)** Date of the inquiry (current date)
- (6) The label "NAME" followed by the person's full name
- (7) The label "ADD" or "WRK" appears on this line. If "ADD" is displayed, the address shown is the person's residence address. If "WRK" is displayed, the address shown is the person's employment address. (Records with a confidential address will display "WRK" and the address as '1905 Lana Ave')
- (8) City, State, Zip Code (nine-digit number)
- (9) County Code: County of residence (see Appendix 5, County Codes)
- (10) HIST means purged information is stored on microfiche in Record Services; otherwise this field will be blank. Because an entry's purge date may occur shortly after the yearly file split, the entry may show on the record up to one year past its designated life span
- (11) Customer Number (Driver License, Permit, ID Card or file reference)
- (12) Sex (M=Male, F=Female, X=not specified or U=unknown)
- (13) Date of birth (zeros if unknown)
- (14) Height in feet and inches (zeros if unknown)
- (15) Weight in pounds (zeros if unknown)
- (16) Issued date. Date of most recent issuance of driver license or instruction permit (original or renewal).
 Replacement (duplicate) issuances and ID card issuances are <u>not</u> shown in this field; they are shown as segments in the variable portion of the record.
- (17) Expiration date of driver's license or instruction permit (ID expiration date is <u>not</u> shown in this field)

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- (18) Created date. The date the customer record was created in CIS. In some cases this date may be an artificial date, as in the case of records created before CIS or before DMV issued photo licenses.
- (19) XLIST displays if the customer is <u>not</u> included on commercial listings. Nothing displays if the person has requested to be included on commercial listings.
- (20) PTR: DMV has sent pointer record information to either the Commercial Driver License Information System (CDLIS) or the National Driver Register (NDR) via the Problem Driver Pointer System (PDPS) or both. This field will display one of the following:

NDR	DMV has sent pointer information to the NDR via PDPS.
CDL	DMV has sent pointer information to CDLIS.
CDL/NDR	DMV has sent pointer information to both the NDR and CDLIS.
Blank	DMV has not sent pointer information.

(21) License Type: Indicates the class of license or permit as well as identification card information. More than one class code may be contained in this field:

License Classes

- **A** <u>Class A Commercial:</u> May operate any vehicle or combination of vehicles with the proper endorsements.
- B Class B Commercial: May operate any single vehicle with proper endorsements. May tow a trailer up to 10,000 pounds GVW or GVWR, whichever is greater. May tow a vehicle more than 10,000 pounds GVW or GVWR, whichever is greater, as long as the combined vehicle weight does not exceed 26,000 pounds GCVW or GCVWR, whichever is greater.
- Class C Commercial: May operate any single vehicle, with proper endorsements, with a GVW or GVWR, whichever is greater, of not more than 26,000 pounds designed to carry more than 16 people (including the driver) or is transporting hazardous materials in quantities that require placarding by law. May tow a trailer up to 10,000 pounds GVW or GVWR, whichever is greater. May tow a trailer more than 10,000 pounds GVW or GVWR, whichever is greater, as long as the combined vehicle weight does not exceed 26,000 pounds GCVW or GCVWR, whichever is greater.
- C Class C: May operate any single vehicle, with proper endorsements, with a GVW or GVWR, whichever is greater, of not more than 26,000 pounds that is designed to carry 16 or fewer persons (including the driver) and not transporting hazardous materials in quantities that require placarding by law. May tow another vehicle with a GVW or GVWR, whichever is greater, of less than 10,000 pounds. May tow a trailer more than 10,000 pounds GVW or GVWR, whichever is greater, as long as the combined vehicle weight does not exceed 26,000 pounds GCVW or GCVWR, whichever is greater. May operate a moped. Firefighters operating emergency fire vehicles are also included in this class, as are operators of recreational vehicles being used for personal use.

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License Classes (continued)

- Out-of-State: Person held an out-of-state license when record was created, i.e. Oregon record was created to record a conviction; there was no Oregon issuance.
- **NONE** None: Person did not have a license when record was created, i.e. record was created to record a conviction or suspension; there was no Oregon issuance.

The following are no longer valid license classes but may still appear on expired records:

- B <u>Class B Restricted</u>. Licensed to drive school buses with a GVWR of 26,000 pounds or less. Displays as Class C with a "1" restriction.
- 1 Licensed to drive any vehicle or combination of vehicles, including Classes 2 5.
- 2 Licensed to drive any bus designed to carry 24 or more passengers and all vehicles in class 3 5.
- 3 Licensed to drive any three-axle vehicle. Also allowed operation of vehicles in class 4 or 5.
- 4 Licensed to drive any 2-axle vehicle, moped, motor home or bus designed to carry fewer than 24 passengers.
- 5 Indicated license to drive moped only.

- **PCDL** Commercial instruction permit
- **CLP** Commercial Learner Permit
- PM Motorcycle instruction permit (all motorcycles regardless of engine displacement)

Identification Card

- I Photo Identification Cards issued at DMV field offices. Will have corresponding variable segment, unless purge criteria is met.
- (22) Used to determine if a person unconditionally qualifies for a farm endorsement based on his/her driving record. This field states either YES or NO. If the field indicates YES, the person qualifies for a farm endorsement. If the field indicates NO, the person does not qualify (lifetime CDL suspension on record) for a farm endorsement or must test to obtain the endorsement.

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- (23) Expiration date of ID card.
- (24) Displays "YES" if person has commercial license and "NO" if person does not have commercial license. This entry cannot be used to determine if a person held a commercial license on any date other than the day the record is accessed.
- (25) Veteran Indicator: Displays "YES" if the card has a veteran designation and "NO" if the card does not have a veteran designation.
- (26) First Licensed Date. Date the driver license was issued. If the person was first licensed prior to March 1, 2000, this field will contain all zeros.
- (27) This field displays endorsements attached to a license. Endorsement codes are:
 - Any vehicle which carries hazardous materials (HAZMAT) that requires placards.
 Motorcycle endorsement for any motorcycle regardless of engine displacement.
 Tank vehicle is designed to transport any liquid or gaseous material within a tank or tanks having an individual rate capacity of more than 119 gallons and an aggregate rate capacity of 1,000 gallons or more that is either permanently or temporarily attached to the vehicle or the chassis. "Tank vehicle" does not include a portable tank having a rated capacity under 1,000 gallons.
 Passenger vehicles designed to carry 16 or more persons, including the driver.
 Moped. No longer used but may still appear on some records.
 School bus used to transport students to/from school or school events.
 - X Combined Hazardous material/tank endorsement
 - Y Farm endorsement (Class A)

This segment goes on a record any time a CDL issuance transaction occurs. It may be an addition or deletion of an endorsement. This segment is also used when a license is upgraded to a higher class of license at a time other than renewal.

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- (a) CDL issuance indicator. Commercial driver license was issued.

State of Record

This segment is entered on the driving record when DMV initiates any type of driver license issuance transaction and the person had a CDLIS record in another state, or when another state's driver licensing authority initiates an issuance transaction for an Oregon driver who has a CDLIS record. This entry is also used to identify corrections to a previous social security number or license number associated with the CDL record. Previously, this entry was used to record the license number of an out-of-state driver.

Restore CDL Segment

This section captures CDL information when DMV downgrades the CDL to a Class C non-commercial license. The person may restore the CDL without taking tests up to three years after the date of the downgrade or three years after the date of the oldest open suspension or cancellation, whichever is earliest, if they meet eligibility requirements.

- (a) Restore Indicator. Used when a commercial driver license is downgraded to a non-commercial license or a Hazmat endorsement is removed.

- (e) Permit types. Lists permit type at the time of downgrade; otherwise, this field is blank.

This segment provides information about the security check needed for a hazardous materials endorsement.

ACCIDENT SEGMENTS

Accident segments are posted to a driver's record after a reportable accident. An accident is reportable when one or more of the following occurs:

- An injury or death to any person;
- Damage to the vehicle you were driving is greater than \$2500;
- Property damage (not including a vehicle involved in the accident) is greater than \$2500; or
- Damage to any vehicle is greater than \$2500 and any vehicle is towed from the scene of the accident due to damages.



Withdrawal is an entry used to record an action taken in another state. DMV only records "Withdrawals" for historical/ informational purposes. Do not use "*Withdrawal*" entries to determine if a driver has valid driving privileges in Oregon or in another state.





DMV uses ACD codes to record convictions occurring in another state on an Oregon driver. See the ACD Code table (Appendix 3) for definitions and additional information.

COLUMN 2 (CITE)

This column references the Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) or other citing authority for the offense. The following are examples of the entries found in this column.

COLUMN 4 (TEXT)

This column contains a summary of the offense as written in applicable law, regulation or rule.

COLUMN 5 (RETAINED)

Indicates the number of years, *from conviction date*, the conviction will show on the record.

- The program to delete record segments is conducted only once a year at the beginning of each year.
- An "*" indicates the retention is 55 years if conviction involved operation of a commercial motor vehicle.

Conviction information shown in _{SUBSCRIPT} text indicates the entry type is obsolete or invalid. Obsolete or invalid entry types are no longer used (entered on records), but may still appear on some driving records.

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ACD Conviction and Withdrawal Codes	1 of 7

ACD CODES: AAMVA (American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators) **C**ode **D**ictionary. These are the national standardized codes used to communicate conviction and/or withdrawal of driving privileges information from state to state. These codes appear on Oregon driving records as convictions and/or withdrawals:

- When a driver licensed in another state moves to Oregon and the driver's previous state driving record is transferred electronically to Oregon.
- When an Oregon licensed driver receives a conviction in another state. The out-of-state conviction is recorded on the Oregon driver record using ACD codes.
- When an Oregon licensed driver receives a withdrawal in another state. The out-of-state withdrawal is recorded on the Oregon driver record using ACD codes.

A "**Withdrawal**" is an action taken in another state. DMV only records "Withdrawals" for historical/ informational purposes. Do not use "*Withdrawal*" *entries* to determine if a driver has valid driving privileges in Oregon or in another state.

The ACD code table is made up of three columns, as follows:

COLUMN 1 (ACD)

This column contains the ACD code for the out-of-state conviction or withdrawal.

COLUMN 2 (DEFINITION)

This column contains a summary of the offense as defined in the AAMVA Code Dictionary.

COLUMN 3 (RETAINED)

Indicates the number of years, *from conviction date*, the conviction will show on the Oregon record. Note: The program to delete record segments is conducted only once a year at the beginning of each year.

ACD codes and information shown in _{SUBSCRIPT} text indicates the entry type is obsolete or invalid. Obsolete or invalid entry types are no longer used (entered on records), but may still appear on some driving records.
